## Clock Fast Ticking for the End of Israel

*"Israel is not a country; rather it is a terrorist camp against the Palestinian people and the rest of the Muslim Ummah. Fighting this despotic regime is fighting oppression and terrorism, and this is a collective responsibility."*

*This was the gist of yesterday's memorable message of the Leader of the Islamic Revolution on the occasion of the annual World Qods Day, which over the past decades has evolved into a humanitarian resolve of all conscientious people for the eventual weeding out of the illegal Zionist entity from the face of the Earth.*

*Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei, whose 25-year deadline for the end of Israel set several years is fast approaching for the eagerly awaited Day of Destiny for the oppressed Palestinian people and the whole Islamic world, pointed out to realities that expose as totally baseless the claims of the West in having planted Israel for East European non-Semitic Khazar Jews on the myth of the holocaust.*

*He rightly remarked: "Today, hope of achieving victory is stronger than ever. Today, the balance of power has swung in favour of the Palestinians. The Zionist enemy has become weaker year after year while its army, which used to describe itself as "invincible", has turned into "a force that never tastes victory" after its debacle in the 33-day war in Lebanon (2006) and its bitter experiences in the 22-day and 8-day wars (in Gaza in the following years)."*

*The Corona pandemic sweeping Iran and the world may have for the moment prevented the Iranian masses from taking to the streets on Qods Day to declare the support for the goal of the liberation of Palestine, but it has not dampened their support and activities – both diplomatic and on the field – for confronting the crimes against humanity of the Zionists.*

*With Iran's peaceful proposal for a referendum to resolve the chronic question of Occupied Palestine ignored by the UN and the powers that control it, especially the satanic US, it is clear that diplomacy has utterly failed for the single state solution and the orderly exit of all European, American, and Russian Jews from Palestine.*

*The only option is to mobilize forces on the field for the coup-de-grace, as was done eight centuries ago in 1187 to liberate Palestine from the usurper Latin Kingdom of Jerusalem by a united army of Turks, Kurds, Arabs, and Iranians.*

*This may happen sooner than later and neither the blind support of the western powers for Israel nor the treason of the Arab regimes will be able to avert the inevitable, thanks to the sacred blood of the martyrs, especially of the Martyr of Qods, General Qassem Soleimani (to quote Hamas Leader, Ismail Haniyeh), who has well paved the ground for the final victory.*

## Amid Reports of Excessive U.S. Demands: Fourth Round of Vienna Talks Ends

VIENNA (Dispatches) — Signatories of a 2015 nuclear deal with Iran ended a fourth round of high-level talks Friday aimed at bringing the U.S. back to the accord, with calls for further efforts to work out the major stumbling blocks.

The talks began in early April and Russian delegate Mikhail Ulyanov tweeted following Friday's meeting that "the participants agreed on the need to intensify the process."

"The delegations seem to be ready to stay in Vienna as long as necessary to achieve the goal," he wrote.

The U.S. pulled out of the landmark 2015 deal in 2018 after then-President Donald Trump said the pact needed to be renegotiated. The deal had promised Iran economic incentives in exchange for curbs on its nuclear program, and the Trump

administration reimposed heavy sanctions on the Islamic Republic in an unsuccessful attempt to bring Tehran into new talks.

Iran reacted by reducing its compliance with the deal, by enriching uranium to a greater purity and using more advanced centrifuges.

U.S. President Joe Biden claims he wants to rejoin the deal, known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action, or JCPOA, but refuses to undo any of the former administration's wrongs.

Iran has said it is prepared to reverse all of its remedial measures taken in response to the other sides' violations but that Washington must remove all sanctions imposed under Trump.

On the other side, the Associated Press wrote, is the question of what Iran's return to compliance would

look like.

"Delegates to the Vienna talks concede, for example, that Iranian nuclear scientists cannot unlearn the knowledge they acquired in the last three years, but it is not clear whether Iran's new centrifuges would need to be destroyed, mothballed and locked away, or simply taken offline," it said.

On Thursday, Press TV said it had learned that the U.S. and the Europeans apparently wanted Iran to destroy its new-generation centrifuges in return for a temporary suspension of some of the sanctions related to the nuclear deal.

This is while under the JCPOA, Iran's advanced centrifuges — including IR-4, IR-6 and IR-9 — must be stored away under the supervision of the International

## Gen. Salami: IRGC Not to Root for Any Candidate

TEHRAN (Dispatches) — The chief of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) says his force will not take sides or act against any candidate in the upcoming presidential election.

"Military men, like the rest of the people of this country, can participate in the elections and this has nothing to do with the organization (IRGC), as it is their personal desire," Major General Hussein Salami said.

The general said there will be no encouragement on the part of the IRGC for officers who register as presidential hopefuls, stressing the force's commitment to taking no position in favor of or against any candidate.

He emphasized that the IRGC is "sincere" in its conduct. "The IRGC is composed of military men who each vote for their desired candidate and there is no movement within the IRGC that would want to decide on who to vote for or not to vote for."

On Wednesday, Iran's Constitutional Council, which interprets the Constitution and vets candidates' qualifications based on those interpretations, announced that military men can from now on run for president without a need to resign from their position.

Military officers, including former IRGC Chief Mohsen Rezaee and former police chief Muhammad Baqer

Qalibaf, had already run for the office — and been approved by the Constitutional Council — in previous elections. But their presidential bids were announced while they were no longer on duty.

Also in the upcoming election, which is scheduled for June 18, former Defense Minister Brigadier General Hussein Dehqan and former head of IRGC's Khatam al-Anbiya Construction Headquarters Saeed Muhammad have put their names forward for the presidential election. Muhammad resigned from his position earlier this year to be able to pursue his presidential ambitions.

## Envoy Urges UN to Force Zionist Regime to Join CWC

UNITED NATIONS (Dispatches) — Iran's permanent representative to the United Nations has called for a full, effective and non-discriminatory implementation of the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC), emphasizing that the occupying regime of Israel must be forced to join the international treaty.

"Politically-motivated approaches and decisions have undermined the authority and credibility of the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW)," Majid Takht-Ravanchi said during his speech at a UN Security Council session on Thursday on chemical weapons in Syria.

He noted that certain states

are abusing the CWC and politically exploiting the OPCW in pursuit of their own interests, describing such practices as a challenge facing multilateralism.

"Unfortunately, such conducts have seriously undermined the Convention, undercut the legitimacy and trust in the OPCW, and caused discord among member states.

"This will further intensify the challenges of disarmament and non-proliferation, including the non-compliance of nuclear-armed states with their obligations under the nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT), and will kick off new nuclear arms races and attempts

Jewish Lawmaker on

## All Monotheists Must Follow Ayatollah Khamenei

TEHRAN (Dispatches) — The representative of the Jewish community at the Iranian parliament has called on all believers in the world to follow Ayatollah Khamenei as the spiritual father of the world's monotheists, in confronting the occupying regime of Israel. Siamak Moreh Sedgh made the appeal as supporters of the Palestinian people marked the International Quds Day across the world on Friday.

In remarks published by Fars news agency on Friday, Moreh Sedgh said the International Quds Day is not just for the Palestinian people but for all the oppressed people in the world.

"On this day, all the oppressed people of the world express their abhorrence of the global arrogance and the Zionist regime, which represents them in the region," he said.

The lawmaker said the Zionist regime is seeking to impose the United States' will on the oppressed people of the region.

Moreh Sedgh said although holding Quds Day rallies is not possible due to the coronavirus pandemic, the Axis of Resistance and freedom-seekers of the world should keep the day alive through social media networks and media outlets.

"All the freedom-seekers of the world must take the Iranian nation as their role model for resisting the arrogance," the Jewish lawmaker said. "And do not get tired of the difficulties in this path and endure the hardships to stand up to the arrogance and Zionism in the same way the Iranian nation has tolerated all the hardships."
