## China to Teach Pelosi an Unforgettable Lesson

*It seems Beijing is determined to teach Washington an unforgettable lesson for the recent violation of China's sovereignty and territorial integrity by US House Speaker, Nancy Pelosi, who is clearly guilty of trespassing for visiting Taiwan.*

*Throughout history trespassing has been regarded as an act of crime which is punishable under the common laws of each and every country.*

*Even in the United States of America, if someone is caught trespassing on another person's property he/she is liable to face trouble, including physical thrashing and possibly a civil lawsuit.*

*A week ago the aging American lady who claims to be a lawgiver openly violated China's law and has entered Taipei without Beijing's authorization, despite warnings from the senior military and civilian officials of her own country.*

*Pelosi's recent trip to Taiwan shows US hypocrisy towards the fundamental rights of other nations.*

*China's Vice Foreign Minister Xie Feng had called her visit as "playing with fire," adding, "the move is extremely egregious in nature and the consequences are extremely serious. China will not sit idly by."*

*It is indeed sheer hypocrisy that the US which claims to be a supporter of peace, human rights, and respect for other countries, feels no inhibitions in violating the sovereignty and territorial integrity of world nations.*

*This is not something surprising of a regime which these very days of August 77 years ago had committed the unpardonable act of terrorism by dropping two atom bombs within a space of three days on the Japanese cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki when World War Two was practically over and Japanese troops on full retreat from the south-eastern Asian fronts.*

*Washington has never ceased its acts of international terrorism which in the 1970s witnessed the brutal war in Vietnam. Today also it is creating chaos all over world, whether it is Yemen, Lebanon, Palestine, Iraq, Bahrain, Libya, Ukraine, and East Asia – let alone its complicity in the unabated crimes of the illegal Zionist entity against Palestinians, Lebanese, Syrians, and the rest of humanity.*

*With this in mind, on Friday, Chinese Foreign Ministry Spokesperson Wang Wenbin blasted Pelosi's visit to (Taiwan on the pretext of defending democratic values as a "major political provocation" and said the visit which only escalated tensions in the region had nothing to do with democracy.*

*He called on the US House Speaker to express remorse and apologize for the atrocities committed by the Americans in Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria, Libya, and other countries.*

*Wang pointed out that her visit had nothing to do with democracy, and was a political trick that ran counter to the will of 1.4 billion Chinese people, including the Taiwanese, who believe in the One-China Policy.*

*He added: "If Pelosi cares so much about democracy and human rights, she'd better visit Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria and Libya where she could express repentance for the killings of hundreds of thousands of civilians by the US military. She could also promise those countries that similar ferocities that resulted from a US violation of the UN Charter and international law norms will never ever be repeated."*

*All this indicates that momentum is building in China to teach Pelosi, if not the entire American regime, a memorable lesson for the UN House Secretary's latest crime against humanity.*

**President Raisi Tell Armenian Prime Minister Pashinyan:**

## Iran Ready to Help Establish Peace in Caucasus

TEHRAN -- President Ebrahim Raisi has told Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan that Iran is ready to use all its capacities to establish peace and stability in the Caucasus region and help its growth and development.

In a phone conversation, Raisi described relations between the two countries as historical and deep, emphasizing the necessity of planning to increase the level of sustainable economic cooperation between Tehran and Yerevan.

The Iranian president touched on the recent border skirmishes between Armenian and Azerbaijani troops, saying the "adherence of the signatories of the tripartite ceasefire statement to its provisions and solving the remaining issues through dialogue and diplomatic solutions is the best way to create peace and security in the Caucasus region", the Tasnim news agency reported.

The tripartite statement was

signed by President Pashinyan and his Azerbaijani and Russian counterparts Ilham Aliyev and Vladimir Putin in November 2020 for a "complete ceasefire and termination of all hostilities in the area of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict" following a 44-day war.

Under the ceasefire, Armenia undertook to return the districts of Aghdam, Lachin and Kalbajar to Azerbaijan after about 30 years and "guarantee the security of transport connections between the western regions of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic in order to arrange unobstructed movement of persons, vehicles and cargo in both directions".

Azerbaijan undertook to "guarantee the security of persons, vehicles and cargo moving along the Lachin Corridor in both directions".

Under the ceasefire agreement, the peacekeeping forces of Russia consisting of 1,960 troops armed with firearms, 90 armored vehicles and 380 motor vehicles and units of special equipment were deployed along the contact line in Nagorno-Karabakh and along the Lachin Corridor.

The parties also agreed that "new transport links shall be built to connect the Nakhchivan Autonomous Republic and the western regions of Azerbaijan", but the condition has turned to a new bone of contention between the warring side, with Baku demanding that Yerevan make way for the establishment of a corridor which the latter refuses.

President Raisi on Wednesday evening touched on the "strategic statements" of Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei during his meetings with the presidents of Russia and Turkey last month regarding the sensitivity of the Islamic Republic of Iran towards its borders in the Caucasus region and confronting any attempt to change them.

## FM Amir-Abdollahian: U.S. Has to Provide Ground for Agreement on Final Text

TEHRAN -- Iran's Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian has called on the United States to provide the ground for the final text of an agreement in Vienna talks by accepting the "legitimate demands" of the Islamic Republic.

"We have conveyed our message to America through the Europeans. We hope that the American side, with a realistic and pragmatic view and acceptance of the legitimate demands of the Islamic Republic of Iran, will provide the ground for an agreement on the final text," he told his Turkish counterpart Mevlut Cavosoglu on phone.

The negotiations between Iran and the Europeans plus Russia and China to revive the 2015 nuclear deal through removing U.S. sanctions on Tehran have dragged on since April 2021. While the Biden administration has claimed to be ready to return to compliance with the deal which its predecessor abandoned in 2018, it has taken no practical measures to undo Washington's past wrongs.

On Monday, an Iranian foreign ministry official dismissed U.S. media reports that a text for restoring the deal with Iran had been completed and that negotiations in

Vienna were finished.

Iranian officials have said they had already conveyed an initial response to the draft and would come back with additional views at a later point.

The Nournews website, which is affiliated to the Supreme National Security Council of Iran, said the Islamic Republic has clearly announced from the beginning that it will not sign a text until it is sure of an agreement on all the discussed issues that will fully secure the interests of the Iranian nation.

## FM Demands Justice on Anniversary of Terrorist Attack

TEHRAN -- Iranian Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian has called on the Taliban to bring to justice those behind the 1998 terrorist attack against the Islamic Republic's consulate in the Afghan city of Mazar-i-Sharif.

Amir-Abdollahian made the call in a post on his Instagram account on Thursday, marking the 24th martyrdom anniversary of eight Iranian diplomats and a journalist in Mazar-i-Sharif.

Amir-Abdollahian said the

day named the Journalists Day is of special significance because "if it were not for the round-the-clock efforts of journalists to reflect the realities, the activities of the diplomats and politicians would be in vain."

"It is journalists that neutralize the enemy's plots and psychological warfare both in the international and domestic arenas, and are the flag bearers of explaining the facts," the top Iranian diplomat said.

He said it is the responsibility of the country's diplomacy to follow up on various aspects of the tragic incident.

In a statement issued on Monday, Iran's foreign ministry paid tribute to the diplomats. The ministry also demanded measures to be taken by Kabul to clarify the circumstances that led to the incident.

The nine Iranian citizens were martyred after militants, allegedly affiliated with the Taliban, entered the city of Mazar-i-Sharif.

## China Denounces Illegal U.S. Sanctions on Iran

TEHRAN -- Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesperson Zhao Lijian has touched on economic losses incurred by Iran due to the United States' sanctions, condemning Washington for its unilateral policies.

"The U.S. is an empire of sanctions," Zhao wrote in a post on his official Twitter account, attaching an image that referred to \$200 billion in economic losses suffered by Iran due to the American sanctions.

The former Iranian government has said U.S.-imposed sanctions have cost Iran at least \$200 billion in less than 2 years; 100 billion for lost crude oil revenues and 100 billion of investment money.

Last month, the Chinese spokesperson voiced Beijing's strong opposition to Washington's "illegal" and "unjustifiable" sanctions as well as its so-called maximum pressure campaign against Iran.

Zhao urged the U.S. to abandon the "wrong practice of resorting to sanctions at every turn" and instead "contribute positively" to negotiations on resuming compliance with the JCPOA, commonly known as the 2015 Iran nuclear deal.

"China has always been firmly opposed to illegal, unjustifiable, and unilateral sanctions and so-called long-arm jurisdiction by the U.S.," he told a press conference in Beijing on July 7.

"The international community, including China, has conducted normal cooperation with Iran within the framework of international law. This is reasonable and lawful without harm done to any third party and deserves to be respected and protected," he added.

After unilaterally withdrawing from the JCPOA in 2018, former U.S. president Donald Trump restored sanctions on Iran as part of what he called the "maximum pressure" campaign against the country. Those sanctions are being enforced to this day by the Joe Biden administration, even though it has repeatedly acknowledged that the policy has been a total failure.

Negotiations started last April in the Austrian capital of Vienna between Iran and the remaining JCPOA parties to revive the
