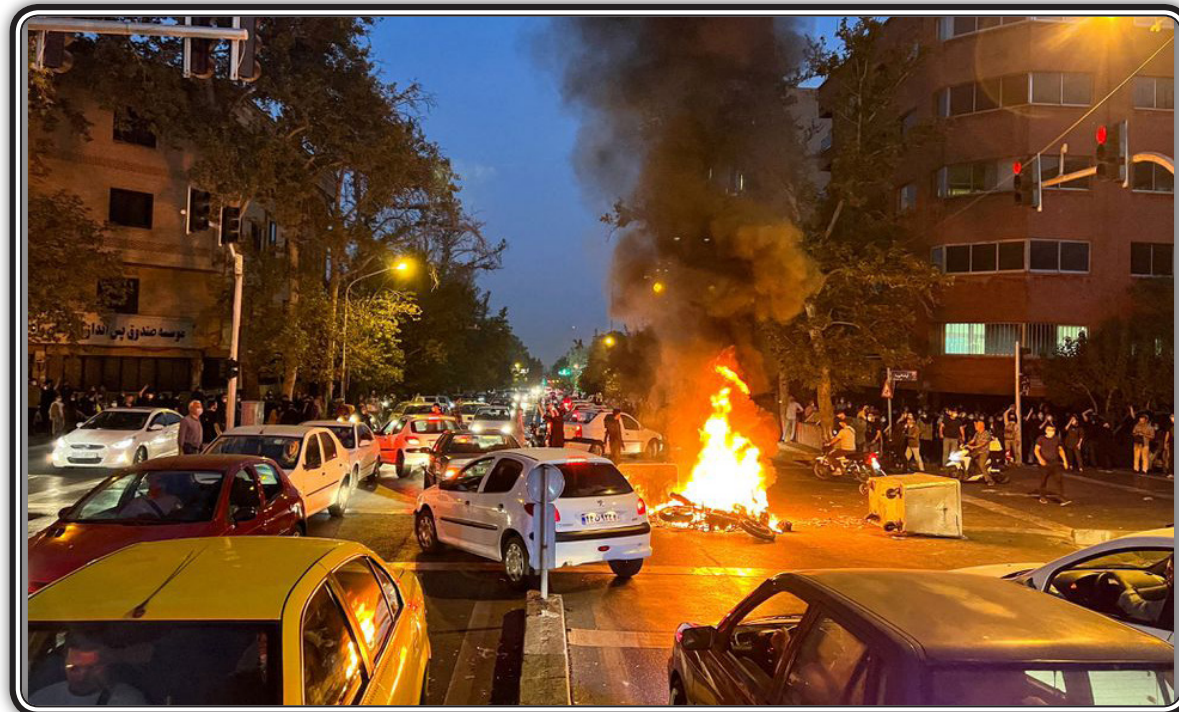

## West Ties Cutting Support for Riots to Concessions

TEHRAN -- A high-ranking Iranian security official said Monday certain Western countries sponsoring and provoking recent deadly riots in Iran have hinted at withdrawing support for the unrest provided that Tehran fully complies with their conditions.

The official, speaking on condition of anonymity, told Arabic-language Al-Alam television news network that the states have suggested that they would adopt the approach on the condition that Iran starts to unconditionally and abundantly inject crude oil and natural gas into global energy markets, which remain unstable in the wake of Russia's military campaign in neighboring Ukraine and coercive measures against Moscow.

He went on to note that the Islamic Republic has also been asked to completely yield to the demands put forward by representatives of three European countries – Britain, France and Germany – as well as those of U.S. delegates during the course of talks on the revival of

the 2015 nuclear deal – officially known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA).

The Iranian security official also pointed to reconciliation with Saudi Arabia and patching up differences with the Riyadh regime on regional issues as the third condition that Western states behind the instigation of anti-Iran riots have set out.

Finally, they have called upon Tehran to sever all diplomatic, economic and trade relations with Moscow, and break off any form of cooperation with Russians.

Political experts and pundits believe that four conditions laid down by Westerners for cutting off support for anti-Iran riots clearly demonstrate that they view rioters as pawns in their battle against Iran's Islamic establishment and that have been pursuing this policy under the disguise of support for human rights and by means of an all-out psychological and media war against Tehran.

Foreign-backed riots have hit various Iranian provinces since

22-year-old woman Mahsa Amini died at the hospital on September 16, three days after she collapsed at a police station. An investigation has attributed Amini's death to her medical condition, rather than alleged beatings by the police.

The violent riots, meanwhile, have claimed the lives of dozens of people and security forces, while also allowing terrorist attacks across the country. In the last two months, the terrorists have set fire to public property and tortured several Basij members and security forces to death.

On October 26, a Daesh-affiliated terrorist attacked the Shah Cheragh shrine in the southern province of Fars before the evening prayers, martyring 13 pilgrims — including a woman and two children — and injuring 40 others.

At least seven people were also martyred after terrorists opened fire at people and security forces at a crowded market in Khuzestan province's Izeh around sunset on Wednesday.

### IRGC Exercising Restraint Vis-à-Vis Kurdistan-Based Terrorists

TEHRAN -- A commander of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) says the forces are very close to the positions of terrorist groups in the Iraqi Kurdistan Region but they will strike the terrorists only if they attack first.

Colonel Delavar Ranjibarzadeh, a commander of the IRGC in the border town of Sardasht in Iran's West Azerbaijan Province, made the remark in an interview with Lebanon's Al-Mayadeen television network.

Ranjibarzadeh said the IRGC forces are monitoring the movements of terrorists in the semi-autonomous region in northern Iraq and that they have been able to prevent them from achieving their goals.

The IRGC forces are capable of reaching the terrorists positioned in the Iraqi Kurdistan Region "but they are not doing so out of respect for neighboring countries," he said. "We are a kilometer away from the terrorists' strongholds, and we are

not targeting them if they do not attack us."

He explained that the IRGC has a lot of intelligence regarding the terrorists' activities, adding, "We target them when attacked. Our forces are fully capable of deterring the terrorists coming from the Kurdistan Region."

"If the IRGC did not bolster their positions in this region, the terrorists would have violated it," Ranjibarzadeh said. He added that the

### Tehran Hospital Carries Out Organ Transplants

TEHRAN -- Organ transplants from three deceased persons have been successfully carried out at a hospital in the Iranian capital, the first such known cases in the Middle East, after the donors were declared dead.

Doctor Sam Zeraatian-Nejad Davani, assistant professor of Cardiovascular Surgery Department of General Surgery, School of Medicine Hazrat-e Rasool General Hospital affiliated with Iran University of Medical Sciences, explained the procedure in a report published by ISNA news agency on Monday.

Davani said that while organ transplants after cardiac death or brain death have been per-

formed for years in Iran, organ transplants from patients who were confirmed dead was carried out for the first time in Iran and the Middle East in association with a knowledge-based company.

Vital organs including kidney, liver, pancreas, intestines, and heart valve were harvested from three dead donors for transplants, Davani said.

While after death both the quantity and quality of organs available for transplant will be adversely affected due to an inflammatory response, as Davani said by using a haemoperfusion cartridge, which helps to remove pro-inflammatory cytokines in

cytokine storm and other cellular inflammatory markers the donors organs remain viable for transplant.

The procedure is approved by the Middle East Society for Organ Transplantation, he added.

A research program is designed to introduce the procedure using a haemoperfusion cartridge (HA380) to other universities of medical sciences in the country to save the lives of people who are on transplant waitlists, he added.

According to the Iran University of Medical Sciences public relations over the past five years, some 700 transplant surgeries were performed in the university's transplant centers.

## Foreign Ministry: No Talks Under Pressure

TEHRAN -- Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesman on Monday reiterated the Islamic Republic's commitment to the talks aimed at reviving the 2015 nuclear deal with world powers but made it clear that Tehran is not willing to negotiate under pressure and threats.

Speaking at a weekly press conference, Nasser Kanaani said American officials know that Iran is not ready to negotiate under pressure and threats.

He said Iran's stance on the talks is "completely clear" and that Tehran is committed to the diplomatic efforts to reach an agreement.

The spokesman noted that reaching an agreement would serve the interests of Iran, the U.S. and European parties to the deal, urging the European countries not to surrender to Washington and its imposed conditions.

He also said Iran had fulfilled its obligations under the nuclear deal, officially known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), and it was the U.S. that violated the agreement.

The European parties to the deal also did not fulfill their commitments and could not compensate the U.S. unilateral withdrawal from the deal, he added.

Asked about a draft resolution aimed to expel Iran from the UN Commission on the Status of Women, Kanaani said, "Any misuse of the internal developments in Iran to exert political pressure on our country is condemned and unacceptable."

The European Union and some western countries have imposed sanctions on Iran over its approach toward the riots.

The Iranian spokesman also said that the U.S. and certain European countries are behind that "political and illegal" draft resolution and that they are seeking to exert pressure on independent countries to pass it.

He said the U.S. move is "an action against the free vote of countries in international organizations and structures."

"There are member countries of the UN Security Council or the
