## Excellent Job by Sana'a to Prevent Theft of Yemen's Oil

The warning shots fired by Yemen's armed forces at the ash-Shihr oil terminal in the province of Hadhramout have for the moment scared away ships in the service of the Saudis and the US, in collaboration with the rebel regime of Aden, to steal the oil of the Arab world's most impoverished state.

It is a pity that at a time when the legitimate government in Sana'a is defending the integrity of Yemen with its heroic resistance against the American-supported invaders from Saudi Arabia and the UAE, the people of the southern parts are being held hostage by a so-called leadership council that has no nationalist interests, and is totally subservient to not just the Wahhabi cultish regime of Riyadh and the clannish Aal-e Nahyan regime of Abu Dhabi, but to Washington and even to the illegitimate Zionist entity.

Last Monday's warning shot at the terminal forced a Panama-flagged tanker anchored near an oil-loading buoy to sail immediately towards the open seas without any stolen cargo.

It was a wise decision by the ship's captain and served notice to any would-be oil smugglers to stay away from the coasts of Yemen.

A month ago on October 21 the armed forces of Yemen had also fired warning shots at the same terminal when the 300,000 dwt VLCC Nissos Kea was about to steal the oil of Yemen on the instructions of the robbers in Riyadh.

This is indeed a peaceful way by the authorities in Sana'a to ensure peace in the region, even though the aggressors have refused to renew the six-month truce that has long expired.

Ship owners and captains of oil tankers ought to take these warnings seriously. They should refuse pressures from the Saudis and the Americans to lease vessels for the organized theft of a partially occupied country, or else the next drone or missile fired on behalf of the oppressed people of southern Yemen from the north by the popular Ansarullah movement at the ash-Shihr or any other terminal might zero-in on the target with the same precision the industrial/military installations of Saudi Arabia have experienced in retaliation for their bombing of civilian centres.

The government in Sana'a whose magnanimity was fully evident on Tuesday when it congratulated its cowardly enemy Saudi Arabia for the freak win over Argentina in the World Football Championship underway in Qatar, very well knows that the Aal-e Saud clan lacks the courage to reciprocate goodwill.

On the contrary, it will continue its devilish policies against Yemen and the people of Yemen – as it does in Bahrain, Syria, Lebanon, Iraq, and recently in Iran where Riyadh's notorious false narrative London-based Farsi TV channel 'Iran International' shamelessly incites thugs, traitors, terrorists, and characterless women to indulge in arson, looting of private property, killing of security personnel and civilians (women and children included), uttering of blasphemous slogans, and sacrilege of Islamic sanctities in the vain hope of causing socio-economic damage to the Islamic Republic.

Anyway, crimes against humanity never go unpunished and no seemingly strong military protector can safeguard those living in glasshouses but foolishly throwing stones at others, whether by committing crimes against the people of Yemen or indulging in terrorism against the people of Iran and other countries, oblivious of the fate in store for them.

Sana'a is doing an excellent job in preventing the theft of Yemen's oil and saving it for the oppressed people of Yemen, but sadly the people of Qatif and the oil-rich eastern coast of the Arabian Peninsula on the Persian Gulf, have been reduced to silent spectators to the stealing of their hydrocarbon wealth on a grand scale by ARAMCO, since they have not yet developed the missiles, drones, and other means of deterrence to drive out the Saudi occupiers and stop the Americans from entering their homeland for the loot.

The day they do it, along with their equally oppressed brethren in Bahrain, by learning the techniques mastered by the brotherly people of Yemen, peace will prevail not just in Arabia, but also in the Persian Gulf and beyond, which will be cleansed of the illegal presence of the CENTCOM terrorists and the Zionist criminals, to the relief of the people of Iran, Iraq, Palestine, Lebanon and Syria (where the US is stealing in broad daylight the oil of the Deir az-Zore region).

# Raisi Calls for Iran-Belarus Partnership to Foil Sanctions

TEHRAN -- Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi on Wednesday called for enhancement of relations among the countries that have been targeted by cruel Western sanctions to neutralize the bans and mitigate their repercussions.

In a meeting with visiting Belarusian Prime Minister Roman Golovchenko here, he said the strong determination of top Iranian and Belarusian officials to improve the level of bilateral ties between Tehran and Minsk can help remove potential obstacles on the path to attain such a goal.

The Iranian president highlighted that the Islamic Republic has made great progress in various fields despite having come under brutal and unprecedented sanctions, saying, "Iran and Belarus enjoy diverse and significant capacities to develop reciprocal interactions."

"Expansion of relations among the countries that have been subject to oppressive sanctions because of efforts to maintain their independence is among the effective mechanisms to offset the bans," Raisi said.

Golovchenko, for his part, stated that Iran's approach to strengthen

regional relations has provided a favorable opportunity for improving the level of relations between Minsk and Tehran.

He pointed out that relations between the two countries have always been friendly, and they have had constructive cooperation at the international level.

The Belarusian prime minister also touched on the three-fold growth of trade between his country and Iran in the past year, emphasizing that Minsk has developed a roadmap for expansion of bilateral ties with Tehran.

## Iraqis Urged to Evacuate Areas New Terrorist Hideouts

TEHRAN -- A senior commander of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) has called upon ordinary Iraqi people to evacuate areas close to the hideouts of separatist terrorists in the Arab country's semi-autonomous Kurdistan region, as his force launched fresh strikes on the positions of the militants.

IRGC Ground Force commander Brigadier General Muhammad Pakpour stated that the force's Hamzeh Seyyed al-Shohada base had launched a new round of missile and drone attacks against the bastions of armed terrorist groups and mercenaries of the global arrogance in Pardi region deep inside Iraqi Kurdistan.

The commander went on to note that the command centers and hideouts of the so-called Kurdistan Freedom Party (PAK) have been pounded because of the separatist group's support for the latest deadly riots in northwestern Iran,

stressing that its main positions were destroyed by precision-strike missiles.

The high-ranking IRGC commander highlighted that Iranian forces will continue their operations until threats being posed by the terrorists are eliminated and they are disarmed.

Pakpour also urged the people living near the hideouts of separatist terrorists in the Iraqi Kurdistan region to stay away from the area.

Earlier, Iranian Ambassador to Baghdad Muhammad Kazem Alesadeq said the Islamic Republic had told officials from Iraq's central government and the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) that it was serious about its national security after a number of sensitive Iranian military centers had been targeted from the Kurdistan soil.

"Some of our vital military centers have been attacked from the Iraqi Kurdistan region's soil and

we have informed the Iraqi side, both the authorities of the Iraqi Kurdistan region and the central government in Iraq, of this issue. We provided them with maps and documents, and they understood this reality," Alesadeq said in an exclusive interview with Iran's Arabic-language television news network Al-Alam TV.

The ambassador dismissed reports about Iran's land advance into the Iraqi Kurdistan region, saying, "Iran respects Iraq's sovereignty and has carried out several measures to improve stability, unity and prosperity in that country."

Since September 24, the IRGC has frequently launched air raids against the positions of the terrorists, who are holed up in Iraqi Kurdistan seeking to ignite riots and unrest in Iran's western border cities.

Iran has, on countless occasions,

## Navy to Unveil Attack Helicopters, Drones

TEHRAN -- Iranian Navy commander Rear Admiral Shahram Irani says his force will soon unveil new homegrown naval attack helicopters and long-range drones, stating the major military achievements will join the country's naval fleet in the near future.

Speaking to reporters at a press conference here, Irani stated that the helicopters will be of great assistance in carrying out maritime operations and will be used for escorting vessels.

He added that the advanced unmanned aerial vehicles will also enable the Iranian Navy's offshore units to cover areas within an operational radius of at least 2,000 kilometers.

Irani said Iranian naval units

are now present in the Indian Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean as well as the Pacific Ocean, and are safeguarding merchant containers and oil tankers owned or leased by the Islamic Republic during their missions in international waters.

The top commander emphasized that the Iranian Navy enjoys the capability to fly hundreds of drones at once to carry out various missions.

"In the next few months, we plan to conduct joint exercises in the northern tip of the Indian Ocean with the participation of countries with which we have signed bilateral or multilateral agreements," he said.

Back in mid-July, Iran's Navy upgraded its force by incorporat-

ing a special division tasked with transporting and operating various drones.

The first drone carrier division of Iran's Navy, which is comprised of different surface and subsurface units, was unveiled in a ceremony in the international waters of the Indian Ocean.

The division is capable of carrying various combat, surveillance, and suicide drones and has joined the country's southern fleet.

Iranian military experts and engineers have in recent years made remarkable breakthroughs in manufacturing a broad range of indigenous equipment, making the armed forces self-sufficient.

Iranian officials have repeatedly

## IRGC Colonel Martyred by Zionist Agents in Syria

TEHRAN -- A senior member of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) Aerospace Division has lost his life in a terrorist bombing using an explosive device near the Syrian capital city of Damascus.

The IRGC said in a statement that Colonel Davoud Jafari, who served as a military advisor in the war-ravaged Arab country, was martyred on Tuesday when a bomb planted by Israeli agents on the side of a road near Damascus went off.

The statement noted that the bogus and criminal Tel Aviv regime will definitely have to pay the price for the act of terror, stating that Jafari's body will be flown back to Iran in the coming days, and information about his funeral procession and burial will be announced accordingly.

Iran maintains an advisory mission in Syria at the request of Damascus with the aim of helping the war-torn Arab country get rid of the foreign-backed militants, who have been fighting against the democratically-elected Syrian government since 2011.

In 2017, Iran's advisory assistance helped Syria defeat the Daesh terrorist group.

Lieutenant General Qassem Soleimani, who was martyred in a U.S. airstrike near the Baghdad International Airport in January 2020, played a key role in the disgraceful defeat of the takfiri outfit.

The occupying regime of Israel has been a key supporter of the terrorist groups operating on the soul of Syria and has targeted the positions of Iran's military advisors as well as those of the Syrian army and resistance groups that have been fighting the terrorists.

Last August, a top member of the IRGC Ground Force, identified as General Abolfazl Aljani, was martyred in Syria.

Back in March, the IRGC said two Iranian advisors named as Colonel Ehsan Karbalayi-Poor and Colonel Morteza Saeed-Nejad had been martyred in an Israeli missile attack on the countryside of Damascus.
