The Reason Behind US Hatred of the Iranian Nation

The US is spiteful of all politically-conscious, religiously-motivated, morally-upright, and independent-minded people throughout the world, especially in countries refusing to bow to Washington's dictates. This explains the intense hatred of the American policymakers towards the Iranian nation, particularly the youths for the past forty-four years, but to no avail.

Army, IRGC Reiterate Solidarity to Protect Iran



More than 40 fighter jets participated in an air parade over Tehran on Tuesday to mark the National Army Day.

TEHRAN – The commanders of the Iranian army and the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps on Wednesday underlined the unshakable solidarity and coordination between their forces in ensuring Iran's security and foiling hostile plots and threats.

IRGC commander Major General Hussein Salami and a number of other senior IRGC generals met Army chief Major General Abdolrahim Mousavi on the occasion of the National Army Day.

Salami described the IRGC and the army as two sturdy pillars of Iran's defense power, saying the two forces' integrity, solidarity, unity, cordial interaction and unbreakable fraternity signify the Islamic Republic's great military power that paves the way for victory over the enemies.

Gen. Mousavi, for his part, lauded the unparalleled rapport between the army and the IRGC. He said while the enemy has mounted pressures and resorted to psycho-

logical war in order to create division, such unity among the Iranian Armed Forces has thwarted the enemy's plots and frustrated its hopes.

The commander also pointed to the army's great advances, saying its young experts have managed to design and manufacture all types of defense equipment inside the country.

In a meeting with a group of top military commanders here Sunday, Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei called on the Iranian armed forces to keep enhancing their preparedness in all areas and do not cease making progress because the threats of the enemies will never fade away.

Meanwhile, Iranian navy chief Rear Admiral Shahram Irani said his force has employed new unmanned aerial vehicles designed and manufactured domestically to detect and destroy hostile vessels and submarines.

Irani made the remarks in an interview with Tasnim news agency, during which he talked about the Islamic Republic's latest progress in the field of drone production.

He said the drone uses a homegrown sonar system and other domestically-developed equipment to stalk and hunt submarines.

The commander noted that the new unmanned aerial vehicle is currently in service in the Iranian navy.

On Tuesday, the Islamic Republic of Iran Army units unveiled a broad range of advanced gear such as homegrown missiles, tanks, armored vehicles, unmanned aerial vehicles, radar systems and air defense missile systems in a military parade marking the National Army Day.

Four divisions of the Iranian army, namely the ground force, the navy, the air force, and the air defense, held military parades on Tuesday in the presence of President Ebrahim Raisi in Tehran.

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Eslami: Iran-IAEA Negotiations Continue

TEHRAN – The director general of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) said Wednesday negotiations are proceeding between Iran and the United Nations atomic organization.

Muhammad Eslami told reporters after a cabinet meeting here that negotiations are progressing and that "technical and expert delegations are going back and forth between Iran and the Agency everyday and are in contact," referring to the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).

"We will report on the results of the work (the negotiations) in due time," Eslami said.

He touched on the development of radiopharmaceuticals inside Iran and said 67 such medicinal items were in distribution at 210 medical centers and hospitals across the country.

Eslami said one million cancer patients had used radiopharmaceuticals in Iran, and that work was underway to increase that capacity.

Two new radiopharmaceuticals are being developed in the current year, he said, adding that all such medication is being produced domestically.

On Tuesday, President Ebrahim Raisi said Tehran has not bowed out of the talks on the removal of sanctions

and the revival of the 2015 nuclear deal, but tries at the same time to neutralize the West's coercive measures.

In a meeting with clerics, Friday prayer imams and groups and seminary students here, Raisi touched on the enemies' efforts to disappoint the people.

He said, "The government considers itself obliged to create hope in the hearts of the people by providing the best and most effective work, and at the same time expects seminars to deal with the enemy's instillation of hope in the field of jihad of enlightenment."

At Least 1,168 Killed in Road Accidents in Nowruz

TEHRAN -- The death toll from road accidents during the two-week Nowruz holidays in Iran has hit 1,168, higher than the previous year, an official said on Wednesday.

Abbas Masjidi Arani, the head of Iran's forensic medicine organization, said during the period between March 16 and April 4, a total of 1,168 people lost their lives in traffic accidents.

He said the maximum number of fatalities was recorded on March 17 and April 2 during the holidays, with the provinces of Fars, Sistan-Baluchistan, Kerman, and Tehran topping the list.

Iran's calendar year starts

on March 21, which sees people traveling within or outside the country.

Last year, the number of casualties from traffic incidents during the holiday season was 1,083.

Road accidents have become a common feature of annual Nowruz holidays in Iran, which experts mostly attribute to reckless driving, lack of adherence to traffic rules as well as poor road safety standards.

The holiday rush is mostly seen in northern Iran's Gilan and Mazandaran provinces, which are located on the coast of the Caspian Sea, as well as southern Fars

Putin's Special Envoy Meets Iranian Ambassador

MOSCOW (Dispatches) -- Tehran's ambassador to Moscow has met with the Russian president's special envoy to discuss an upcoming four-way summit on peace in Syria, which is expected to be held in early May.

Kazem Jalali sat down for talks with Mikhail Bogdanov in Moscow on the agenda of the forthcoming summit that will bring Iran, Russia, Syria and Turkey to the negotiating table.

During the meeting, Jalali and Bogdanov emphasized the importance of the peace initiative for strengthening the stability and security of the region, calling for a continuation of efforts to bring the viewpoints of the conflicting parties closer together.

Syria has been grappling with foreign-sponsored militancy since 2011.

Iran and Russia have been providing aid to Damascus in its fight against takfiri terror groups, while Turkey has been supporting a number of militants fighting the Damascus government.

Over the past years, Iran, Russia and Turkey have been mediating a peace process between Syria and a number of opposition groups aimed at ending the militancy.

The summit was initially planned to be held in March, but reports said it was postponed as Damascus sought guarantees from Ankara to stop "supporting terror groups" and ending the military occupation of parts of the country.
