TEL AVIV (Dispatches) -- Protesters have stormed a parliamentary committee session in Occupied Al-Quds on Wednesday amid growing outrage over Benjamin Netanyahu's refusal to agree to a deal to end hostilities in Gaza and release Israeli captives. They pushed into the Knesset Finance Committee discussion, demanding action from the lawmakers to free their family members held by the fighters of the Palestinian resistance movement Hamas since October 7, 2023.
