## President Raisi Tours Exhibit of Technological Achievements



President Raisi toured the exhibition of more than 2,000 knowledge-based products in different sectors in Tehran on Monday.

TEHRAN – President Ebrahim Raisi on Monday visited an exhibition of knowledge-based technology products held by the Iran House of Innovation and Technology (iHiT) at the Tehran International Exhibition Center.

Raisi toured the exhibition as part of a visit to Iranian Presidency's Deputyship for Science and Technology.

The fair showcases more than 2,000 knowledge-based products in different sectors such as agriculture machinery, transport, water and energy, smart homes, electricity, laboratory equipment and med-

icines.

Nearly 690 companies are exhibiting their products in an area of 3,500 square meters.

The iHiT headquarters is located at Tehran International Exhibition Center and acts as a hub for export of Iran's science and technology products.

Branches of iHiT have already been established in countries like Kenya, Syria, China, and Russia, Uzbekistan, Turkiye and Iraq.

The center has been established with the aim of promoting hardware infrastructure as well as

trading and exporting knowledge-based technologies. One of its important missions is to introduce the capabilities of Iranian knowledge-based companies to international markets.

Almost 9,600 knowledge-based companies are currently active across Iran, which have created 328,479 jobs in the current Iranian calendar year that ends on March 20, 2024.

This comes as the companies have exported some \$1,890 million worth of products over the same period.

## Gen. Bagheri: Zionist Regime's Defeat 'Irreparable'

TEHRAN -- The chairman of the Chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces said on Monday the Zionist regime has undoubtedly suffered an "unprecedented and irreparable" defeat in its war against the oppressed people of Palestine.

"The Zionists seek to make up for their defeat by killing defenseless people, which is definitely not possible," Major General Muhammad Bagheri said.

He added that Israel's onslaught on Gaza was a "big incident" that marked a new history for the region and even the entire world, empha-

sizing that no power can change the "quite clear" fate of the war.

In this war, Bagheri said, the oppressed Palestinian people and their supporters, including Yemen, the Lebanese Hezbollah resistance movement, and Iraqi resistance groups are fighting against the shameless and criminal Zionist regime, as well as the U.S. and Europe.

During the genocidal war, Israel, the U.S. and Europe exposed their empty rhetoric about advocating human rights and democracy, he said.

The top Iranian commander added

that some countries in the Muslim world claim to support the Palestinian people "but in practice and contrary to the will of their people, they support the Zionists."

Some of those countries allow Israel-bound ships to dock and load goods at their ports, while several others provide Israel with oil and oil transition pipelines, he said.

Bagheri warned that those countries would face a far worse fate than the Zionists, emphasizing that the people of Palestine and the Muslim world are well aware of the realities on the ground.

## Iran: Munich Security Conference on Wrong Track

TEHRAN – Iran on Monday denounced the organizers of the Munich Security Conference (MSC) for taking advantage of the forum to express their unconstructive opinions and inviting Zionist officials to the event.

"We are decidedly worried about the Munich Security Conference and about the purposes its founders had defined," Foreign Ministry spokesman Nasser Kanaani told reporters here.

He said the MSC organizers are on the wrong track by turning the conference into a mechanism for expressing their own unconstructive and unfair views against independent states.

Kanaani deplored the organizers of the MSC for excluding certain countries with a significant role in regional security and inviting the notorious criminal officials with a dark record to the conference.

"If only the conference had

invited the legitimate representatives of the Palestinian nation to declare their views instead of inviting the officials of the Zionist regime who have committed genocide," he said.

The 60th Munich Security Conference ended on Sunday after talks among many international decision-makers, including heads of state and government, ministers of defense and foreign affairs, as well as leading figures from academia, business and civil society.

The conference was also attended by the Israeli president, Isaac Herzog, whose regime has martyred more than 29,000 Palestinians in Gaza since October 7.

Kanaani dismissed attempts to tie an urgent ceasefire in Gaza to the political future of the Palestinian enclave.

"While the bulk of world nations are demanding an urgent ceasefire and cessation of Israeli crimes against the people

of Gaza, the Zionist regime is reluctant to stop the war, since it has not achieved its purposes," he said.

He said only the Palestinian nation has the right to decide the fate of Gaza.

The spokesman said Iran has expressed its readiness to host a second meeting of the foreign ministers of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) on the Gaza war.

Algeria has proposed a new resolution that seeks an "immediate humanitarian ceasefire" in Gaza. It will be put to a vote at the UN Security Council on Tuesday. The U.S., however, has said it will block the motion.

"What is happening in Gaza is not only an obvious crime and genocide, but also a threat to international peace and security," Kanaani said. "The international community and bodies must stop these actions."

## IRGC Navy Receives Two New Combat Vessels

TEHRAN -- The naval force of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) on Monday received two new home-made combat vessels equipped with medium and long-range missiles.

The two vessels, named the Martyr Bagheri and the Martyr Shirazi, joined the IRGC Navy fleet during a ceremony held in the port city of Bandar Abbas, the capital of Hormuzgan province in southern Iran.

IRGC Navy commander Admiral Alireza Tangsiri, who was present at the ceremony, said that the two vessels belong to Martyr Soleimani class of domestically-made advanced warships.

The Martyr Bagheri and the Martyr Shirazi are each 67 meters in length and are equipped with home-made long and medium-range missiles, Tangsiri said, adding that they can navigate 5,500 nautical miles (9,500km).

Weighing 600 tons and having 4 engines, the newly-added vessels can navigate at a speed of 32 nautical knots (about 60 km/h), he said.

The IRGC commander also explained that the surface-to-surface missiles placed at these vessels have a range of at least 700 km. The air defense system of the vessels has a range of 90 km, he added.

Tangsiri further said that the Martyr Bagheri and the Martyr Shirazi vessels can carry helicopters and three missile-launcher vessels, while they are capable of conducting close combat in the sea.

## Lawyer Slams Sweden's Decision to Uphold Life Sentence for Nouri

STOCKHOLM (Dispatches) -- The Swedish Court of Appeals has made a wrong and very disappointing decision to confirm the life sentence handed to Hamid Nouri, a former Iranian judiciary official who has been illegally incarcerated in Sweden, his Swedish lawyer said Monday.

The Swedish trial and appeal courts had different interpretations of what constitutes a crime against international law and murder but they issued identical verdicts, Thomas Bodstrom told Mizan news agency.

He added that the Stockholm Court of Appeals refused to examine the very strong defense presented by Nouri's lawyers.
