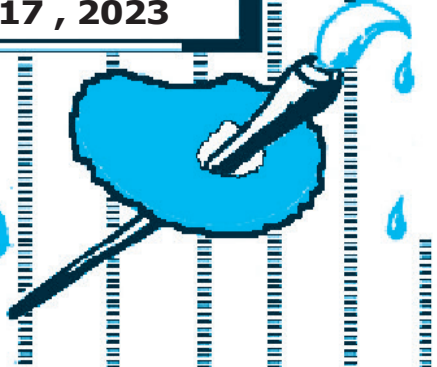
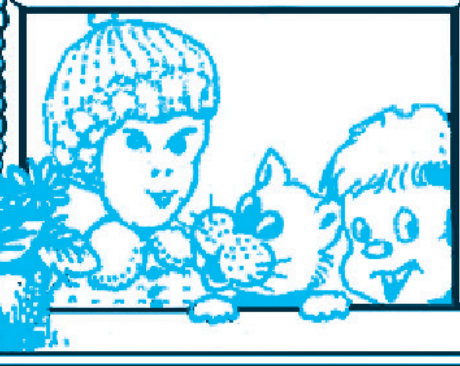

Immortal Legacy

Salaam dear young friends and hope you are fine by the Grace of Almighty God.

Yesterday, the 25th of Shawwal was the day of sorrow and grief and on this doleful day, Prophet Mohammad's (blessings of God upon him and his progeny) 6th Infallible Heir, Imam Ja'far Sadeq (AS) was martyred.

He was the victim of a fatal dose of poison given to him in Holy Medina on the orders of the wicked caliph of the usurper Abbasid regime in Baghdad, Mansour Dawaniqi.

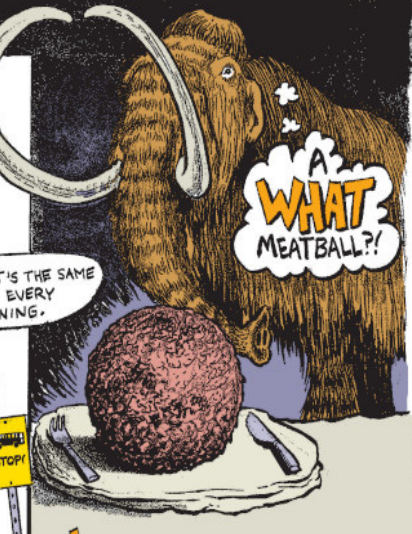
