TEHRAN - Iran's national wheelchair basketball team defeated Iraq 83-41 in the 2022 IWBF (International Wheelchair Basketball Federation) World Championships underway in Dubai, UAE on Wednesday. Iran has already lost to two-time champion Britain 90-59 and the US 82-74 at the 2022 IWBF World **Championships**

Iran, the UK, the USA, and Iraq are in Group D, while Group A consists of Australia, Italy, Brazil,

and the UAE

Egypt, Germany, Canada, and Thailand are in Group B, while the Netherlands, Argentina, South Korea, and France are drawn in Group С.

The 2022 IWBF World Championships are being held in Dubai, UAE.

The competition was originally scheduled for November 16 to 27, 2022, but was postponed to June 9 to 20, 2023.

Venus Loses to Swiss Teen on Return to Competition



ROSMALEN, Netherlands (Reuters) - Venus Williams' re-

turn to action following a fivemonth injury layoff ended in defeat as the seven-times Grand Slam champion fell to Swiss teenager Celine Naef in three sets at the Libema Open grasscourt tournament in Rosmalen, Netherlands.

With sister Serena, who retired last year, watching on in the crowd, the 42-year-old Williams started brightly but lost the closely fought second in the

tiebreak before fading in the decider on Tuesday.

The former world number one, a five-time winner at Wimbledon, lost 3-6 7-6 (6-3) 6-2 to 17-year-old Naef in two hours and 18 minutes.

"I cannot believe I had the chance to play against Venus," Naef said after her first win on the WTA Tour. "She's an amazing player and really a role model for anyone."

Williams, who was handed a wildcard for the tournament, had been sidelined since January after sustaining a hamstring injury in Auckland that forced her to

not sign a new contract.

MANCHESTER, England (AP) — Kylian Mbappe's decision not to take up the option of a 12-month extension on his Paris Saint-Germain contract could spark a bidding war for the French superstar this summer.

PSG is adamant he will not be allowed to leave as a free agent when his current deal runs out at the end of next season, meaning he could be put up for sale during this transfer window if a resolution over his future is not agreed.

Real Madrid has coveted Mbappe for a number of years and in 2021 unsuccessfully launched a bid of \$190 million to take him to the Bernabeu. The Spanish giant would appear to be the likeliest destination for the World Cup-winning forward — especially at a time when it needs to find a replacement for Karim Benzema, who has joined Saudi Arabian team Al-Ittihad.

But Mbappe has this week described reports claiming he wants to move to Madrid this summer as "lies."

Lewandowski Rules Out Move to Saudi Arabia

WARSAW (Reuters) - FC Barcelona striker Robert Ledowski ruled out moving to the Saudi Professional League this summer as "he has other priorities" and his contract with the Spanish champions is valid until 2026. In his first season in the Spanish La Liga the Pole definitely met expectations as he led Xavi Hernandez' team to the league title and he was the best scorer of the competition with 23 goals. According to some media, after a stunning season, Lewandowski's future was in question as his name has been put on the wishlists of several clubs. Sky Sports Deutschland journalist Florian Plettenberg shared reports the Pole was on the radar of clubs from Saudi Arabia

However, the forward emphasized that he is fully focused on playing for Barcelona.

North Korea Register for Asian Games in China - Report

BEIJING (Reuters) North Korea has registered to participate in this year's Asian Games in China, a move that could potentially mark the country's comeback to the international sports stage after the CO-VID-19 pandemic, Kyodo reported on Wednesday.

The Asian Games will take place in Hangzhou, China, from Sep. 23 to Oct. 8, a year after being postponed due to the CO-VID-19 pandemic, but it is not known if North Korea will ease its tight CO-VID-19 restrictions. North Korea have self-imposed lockdowns aimed at preventing COVID-19 outbreaks and are under strict

international sanctions over its nuclear weapons and ballistic missile programs. North Korea skipped the 2024 Olympic Games

qualifying weightlifting competition in Cuba earlier this month after registering 14 athletes for the tournament.

Kyodo reported that China's deputy sports minister Zhou Jinqiang said that this year's edition would be the "largest and highest-level international comprehensive sports event", with 45 Olympic Asian committees participating.
