President Raisi Off to Tajikistan, Uzbekistan for 2-Day Visit



TEHRAN—Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi is scheduled to leave capital Tehran for official visits to Tajikistan and then Uzbekistan.

President Raisi will depart for Dushanbe at an official invitation by his Tajik counterpart Emomali Rahmon on Wednesday morning.

Upon his arrival, the two presidents will hold a private meeting and then, they will take part in a session with the presence of Iranian and Tajik merchants and economic managers. The Iranian and Tajik officials are also to ink some memoranda of understanding (MoUs).

In the second leg of his tour, President Raisi will visit Uzbekistan at the official invitation by his Uzbek counterpart Shavkat Mirziyoyev to take part in the 16th Summit of the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO), which is scheduled to take place in Tashkent on November 8–9.

Raisi intends to explain the stances of the Islamic Republic of Iran during the summit and hold talks with a number of leaders and authorities participating in the two-day event.

Consultations on mutual trade cooperation as well as international issues such as the critical

situation in Gaza are among the main topics of negotiations between the Iranian president and other officials during his two-day trip.

ECO is a governmental and regional organization, which was established in 1985 by Iran, Pakistan, and Turkiye in a bid to promote economic, technical, and cultural collaborations among member states.

In 1992, some seven new members, including Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan joined the organization, and it comprises 10 member states at present.

FM: U.S. Abetting Zionist Crimes Despite Global Condemnation

TEHRAN – Iranian Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian has said that Washington prefers to aid and abet the Zionist regime which has already fallen apart.

Denouncing the U.S. for ignoring calls for ending the Israeli war on Gaza, in a post on his X account on Tuesday, the top Iranian diplomat decried the U.S.' unconditional support for the Israeli regime's atrocities against Gaza.

He said more than 120 countries have called for an end to the Israeli war on Gaza and millions of people across the world, even in Washington, D.C., have rallied to express solidarity with Palestinians and condemn the Zionist war crimes.

"However, the White House prefers to remain as an accomplice and stand with the fallen Israeli regime at the expense of opposing the world public opinion," he added.

Iran, Egypt Explore Ways to End Gaza Crisis

In a telephone conversation, Amir-Abdollahian and his Egyptian counterpart Sameh Shoukry, the ministers discussed the joint efforts to help Palestine and stop the Zionist regime's brutal strikes against the people of Gaza.

Pointing to the stances adopted by Iran and Egypt as two important Islamic countries, Amir-Abdollahian said continued bilateral talks is crucial to putting an end to the ongoing crisis in Palestine and the Israeli regime's savage strikes against civilians in Gaza and the West Bank.

He also noted that the upcoming summit of the Islamic countries in Riyadh is significant and Tehran is ready to continue consultations with Cairo, the Foreign Minis-

try's website reported.

Amir-Abdollahian asserted that the Iranian Red Crescent Society is ready to send humanitarian aid to Gaza through Egypt.

Meanwhile, Shoukry expounded on Egypt's measures to send international humanitarian aid to the people in Gaza. He also hailed the positions adopted by the Arab and

Islamic countries as well as those of Iran and their efforts in this regard.

He also underlined the necessity for constant bilateral and multilateral talks to help stop the conflict, establish truce in Gaza, and send humanitarian aid to the people in the besieged enclave.

Top Rights Official: Gaza War a 'Genocide'

TEHRAN - Secretary of Iran's High Council for Human Rights Kazem Gharibabadi on Tuesday said that Zionists' genocidal war on the Gaza Strip has killed and injured at least 40,000 people.

Addressing a meeting in Tehran on unfolding tragedies in Gaza, Gharibabadi stated that both human rights and international law are being blatantly violated in light of Zionist atrocities in the blockaded enclave.

"Over the past month, the Zionist regime has perpetrated all forms of crimes in the Gaza Strip. What is going on there could be best explained as a crime against humanity, war crime, genocide as well as racial and ethnic cleansing within the jurisdiction of international criminal law, for which there exist abundant evidence," Gharibabadi said.

He added that at least 40,000 Gazans have been killed and injured in the last 32 days, stressing that while 100,000 Palestinians have lost their lives over a span of 75 years as a result of the Zionist occupation, 10,000 people have been killed in the Gaza Strip in just one month.

Gharibabadi also pointed out that more than 70% of the victims in Gaza are women and children.

"Contrary to their claims about advocacy for the rights of women and children, Western countries have kept mum on the matter. Employment of internationally-banned munitions such as white phosphorus bomb, forced displacement, extermination of population by blocking the entry of food and medicine, along with siege and encirclement of Gaza population since October 8, are examples of offenses committed by the Zionist regime under the international criminal law," Iran's top rights official stated.

He went on to say that civilian facilities, such as homes, educational and religious centers, and hospitals have been bombarded
