## Defense Minister: Enemies Wary of Iran's Severe Response to Wrong Acts

TEHRAN – Defense Minister Brigadier General Muhammad Reza Ashtiani said on Tuesday that adversaries have realized that any mistaken move against Iran will draw a harsh reaction, which is why they have opted for unknown threats against the Islamic Republic.

During a visit to a research organization of the Defense Ministry, General Ashtiani said the enemies are well aware that Iran is capable of detecting, tracking and

thwarting all conventional threats. "The enemies know that if they make any mistake, they will face the Islamic Republic of Iran's firm and decisive reaction. Thus, they have opted for unknown and new threats in their new plots against the Islamic Republic of Iran," the defense minister added.

In comments on October 9, the spokesperson for the Iranian Foreign Ministry cautioned the Zionist regime that any act of aggres-

sion against the Islamic Republic would trigger a devastating response.

"The parties that issue threats against Iran must be mindful of their legal responsibilities. Such remarks result in accountability and they should bear in mind that Iran is never constricted in defending its rights," the spokesman underlined, noting that Iran's responses have always made the aggressors regret their move.

### President: Iran Seeks Enhanced Ties With Thailand, Slovenia

TEHRAN -- President Ebrahim Raisi on Tuesday received the credentials of new ambassadors from Thailand and Slovenia in separate ceremonies in Tehran, underlining Iran's friendly relations with those countries while calling for efforts to further expand bilateral ties.

While receiving the credentials of Pichit Boonsud, Thailand's new ambassador, President Raisi described the relations between the two countries in friendly terms.

He emphasized that efforts were required to elevate the level of bilateral relations further, expressing hope that the new ambassador would work towards enhancing the friendly relations between the two nations.

Boonsud, for his part, stated that his country's foreign policy is focused on developing relations in line with mutual interests.

"As the ambassador of Thailand, I will make every effort to raise the level of friendly relations between the two countries," he said.

The ambassador expressed hope that the Islamic Republic would be interested in exchanging its capabilities in scientific and economic fields, especially in the production of medicines and medical equipment, with Thailand.

President Raisi also received the credentials of Igor Jukič, the new ambassador of Slovenia to Iran, on the same day.

He acknowledged the positive state of bilateral relations in vari-

ous sectors but considered them yet insufficient. The president emphasized the need for further efforts to improve the level of interactions and expand bilateral relations between the two countries.

Referring to the failures of the enemies in attempting to halt Iran's progress, President Raisi highlighted Iran's extensive economic and scientific capacities, which provide an excellent platform for enhancing relations with allies such as Slovenia and securing the interests of both.

Jukič assured that during his tenure, he would endeavor to elevate bilateral relations between the two nations and strengthen their cooperation on an international level.

### Iran's FM: U.S. Fanning Flames of Gaza War

TEHRAN - Iran's Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian says despite duplicitous messages sent by the leaders of the United States, Washington is fanning the flames of the Zionists' ongoing genocidal war on the Gaza Strip by sending arms consignments to the occupying regime.

Amir-Abdollahian made the remark in a late press conference following the conclusion of the second 3+3 regional platform meeting, dubbed "Time for Peace, Cooperation, and Progress in the South Caucasus."

"One of the important issues raised during the meeting was the issue of Palestine" and the ongoing Zionist war on Gaza, Amir-Abdollahian said, noting that his Turkish and Russian counterparts had taken "strong positions in favor of cessation of the war."

The Iranian top diplomat was referring to the devastating war that Israel has been waging against the besieged Gaza Strip since

October 7, after the Gaza-based Palestinian resistance groups staged Operation al-Aqsa Storm, a surprise attack into the occupied territories, in response to the Zionist regime's intensified crimes against the Palestinian people.

"Unfortunately, the United States has been offering its one-sided and full support to the Zionist regime," Amir-Abdollahian said, adding, "Today, the American security apparatus is managing" Israel's war on Gaza.

"The administrative and political system in the occupied territories has completely fallen apart, but under direct supervision of American military personnel, the regime's war machine is trying to save the collapsed [Israeli] regime from crisis," he added.

The Iranian foreign minister also pointed to American officials' frequent visits to the occupied territories and their under-way efforts to have the United Nations Security Council pass

a resolution to portray Israel's genocidal crimes as an instance of "self-defense."

The Iranian official said he has brought up this issue with his Russian and Chinese counterparts during the Tehran meeting, noting, "All of our efforts are aimed at preventing a resolution from being issued against the resistance movements in Palestine."

Iran's foreign minister then touched on the United States' direct involvement in the Zionist war on Gaza and the Tel Aviv regime's efforts to prevent humanitarian aid from reaching the coastal territory.

A U.S. official told the Associated Press (AP) news agency that the Pentagon has sent military advisers, including a Marine Corps general versed in urban warfare, to Israel to aid in its planning for the war in Gaza.

One of the officers leading the

### Pro-Zionist Speech Triggers Walkout at IPU Assembly

TEHRAN – The parliamentary delegation of Iran and representatives of many other Muslim states walked out of the opening of the 147th Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) in Angola in protest at a speech in favor of the Zionist regime and against the Palestinian resistance.

The Iranian delegation, led by the vice speaker of the Iranian Parliament, has attended the IPU Assembly in Angola's Luanda.

During a speech to the inaugural ceremony of the assembly on Monday evening, IPU President Duarte Pacheco adopted a biased attitude in favor of the Zionist regime and branded the Palestinian resistance as terrorist groups.

The delegation of Iran, including several lawmakers and Iran's accredited ambassador to Angola, as well as the representatives of many other Islamic nations walked out of the meeting in protest at the IPU president's comments.

The Muslim delegations returned to the assembly after Pacheco's speech and gave a sharply worded response to his stances against the Palestinian resistance.

Afterwards, President of Angola Joao Manuel Goncalves Lourenco took the podium and voiced concern about the situation in the Gaza Strip.

He also stressed the need for collective action to prevent a humanitarian catastrophe in the besieged enclave.

At least 5,300 Palestinians have been killed and thousands of others wounded in Israeli attacks since October 7, when Hamas launched a surprise operation outside Gaza.
