Cameron's Return to Resurrect Israel

Ever heard of a former prime minister having served a full term in office later returning to politics by accepting a lower cabinet post?

It is against the dignity of any ex executive head of state to apparently stoop so low, is the answer – unless ulterior political motives are involved.

Monday's appointment as Foreign Secretary of one-time British Prime Minister David Cameron (although as the rule requires he is not even a sitting member of parliament having resigned a few months after end of 6-year term as head of government in 2016), may have raised the eyebrows of the naïve.

The knaves who run the show behind the scenes in London, however, had a precedent of a similar case a century ago pertaining to Palestine and Zionism, and this time the urgent need to avert the collapse of Israel which is being flayed worldwide for its unabated genocide of Palestinians in Gaza.

James Arthur Balfour, Britain's prime minister during the years 1902-05, was known to be a friend of Chaim Weizman, a Russian-born non-Semitic Khazar Jew who founded the racist outfit Zionism.

In view of this friendship, in 1916 when during the First World War Britain was all set to seize Palestine from the Ottoman Empire, Balfour took up the foreign secretary's post in the cabinet of Prime Minister Lloyd George and a year later in November after the retreat of the Turks from the Levant, he drafted the infamous 'Balfour Declaration' calling for a state in Occupied Palestine for east European converts to Judaism.

Having died in 1930 he didn't live up to see the fulfillment of his devilish dream of the illegitimate birth in 1948 of Israel, which over the past seventy-five years, with British and American help has grown into a monster committing the worst crimes against humanity.

Now, when the illegal Zionist entity had virtually collapsed on October 7 as a result of the heroic 'Operation Al-Aqsa Storm' of the besieged defenders of Gaza and Israel is on life-support while the US – and also British – commanders are directing the defeated child-killer Benjamin Netanyahu's cowardly soldiers to indulge in the carnage of civilians, David Cameron's first act in office yesterday was to impose sanctions, not on the perpetrators of terrorism, but on leaders of the anti-terrorism movement, Hamas.

He is on record of stating during his visit to Tel Aviv in March 2014 as British prime minister of his "unshakeable belief in the Balfour Declaration" and feeling proud of London's creating of Israel in Palestine.

So, what can be expected from such an avowed supporter of Zionism?

Nothing positive, is the answer, except sweet words of a two-state (impractical) solution to please the duped and deceived heads of Arab states who still look to London as overlord, accompanied by vague talk of a ceasefire in Gaza in order to whitewash the badly tarnished image of Israel and try to prolong the precarious survival of the illegal Zionist entity, through Machiavellian diplomacy.

The reshuffle in White Hall and the immediate granting of the title of 'baron' to the commoner Cameron in order to be a member of the upper house of Britain's bicameral parliament are mere cosmetic measures.

The return of the 'White Sahib' to politics is not the work of the 'Sepoy' Rishi Sunak who could be immediately replaced when required, but of the powerful and hidden Zionist lobby that supervises Britain's imperialistic policies.

FM Amir-Abdollahian: World Must Press Zionists to End Gaza Onslaught

TEHRAN - Iran's Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian in a phone call with his Hungarian counterpart, Péter Szijjártó has strongly condemned the ongoing massacre of Palestinians in the besieged Gaza Strip by Zionists as a blatant violation of international law.

During the conversation, the two top diplomats discussed various aspects of bilateral relations as well as the latest developments in the West Asia region, especially the situation in Palestine and Zionists' genocide in Gaza.

Referring to deteriorating humanitarian conditions in Gaza as a result of Zionists' savage crimes, Iran's foreign minister said, "Through indiscriminate bombardment and massacre of people in the Gaza Strip, this Israeli regime has blatantly violated all norms of human rights and international law."

Amir-Abdollahian also underlined the necessity of mounting pressure on Zionists by the international community to put an immediate halt on the regime's aggression against

Gaza, establish a ceasefire across the territory, and pave the way for the dispatch of humanitarian aid.

Zionists started the war on Gaza on October 7 after the territory's resistance groups launched Operation al-Aqsa Storm in response to the regime's intensified crimes against Palestinians.

Since then the Palestinian death toll from Zionist strikes has climbed to 11,240, including 4,630 children and 3,130 women. More than 28,000 people have been also injured in the regime's military onslaught.

Zionists have also blocked supply of water, food, electricity, and medicines to Gaza, plunging the coastal area into a humanitarian crisis. The regime has been defying global calls for a ceasefire as well.

On Sunday, the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) sounded a stern alarm about the humanitarian situation in the besieged Gaza Strip, saying, "The situation in Gaza is rapidly approaching a humanitarian disaster."

"An unbearable human tragedy

is unfolding in front of our eyes. People call us day and night saying they are afraid to open their doors for fear of getting killed and pleading to help them reach safety," said William Schomburg, head of the ICRC's sub-delegation in Gaza.

The ICRC also expressed alarm at the regime's targeting of heavily populated urban areas, saying, "Zionist attacks taking place in heavily populated urban areas in the Gaza Strip, including around hospitals, endanger the lives of the most vulnerable people like medical staff, patients, the wounded, premature babies, people with disabilities, and the elderly."

Elsewhere in his remarks, Amir-Abdollahian expressed satisfaction over the growing ties between Iran and Hungary, declaring Tehran's readiness to hold a meeting of the two countries' joint commission.

The Hungarian top diplomat, for his part, expressed hope that relations between the two countries would further develop in all areas of mutual interest.

Bagheri Kani: U.S. Definitive Loser in Gaza's Unequal Combat

TEHRAN – The Deputy Foreign Minister of the Islamic Republic of Iran Ali Bagheri Kani on Tuesday said that regardless of the outcome of the ongoing unequal battle in the Gaza Strip, the definite loser will be the United States.

Speaking in a seminar in Tehran, Bagheri Kani said that Palestine is the best example of human rights violations in the world, "because in the scene of Palestine, one side is the aggressor, the occupier and the criminal who violates all the basics and rules of human rights, and the other side is the oppressed nation that owns the land of

Palestine, whose rights have been violated and is trying achieve its rights by all means."

The deputy foreign minister further pointed out that whatever the outcome of the unequal war in Gaza, the United States is the definite loser.

He further said that the huge blow that the Resistance inflicted on October 7 (Al-Aqsa Storm Operation) took the United States and Israeli regime by surprise in a way that they have not returned to their normal activities. "That is why they intend to compensate for this historic and strate-

gic failure by killing women and children and destroying the infrastructure of the impoverished Gaza region."

He called on Muslim nations to take practical actions rather than just verbally condemning the aggression by the Zionist regime.

"By expanding boycotting the Zionist goods and banning the export of oil and other basic goods to this regime, the serious determination of Islamic governments to support human rights and defend the oppressed people of Gaza should be shown," Bagheri Kani further asserted.

Spokesman Condemns Zionist Attack on Qatari Organization in Gaza

TEHRAN – The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iran on Tuesday condemned the Zionist shelling of the Gaza Reconstruction Committee, saying such a crime lays bare the savage nature of the regime.

In a statement, Iranian Foreign Ministry spokesperson Nasser Kanaani denounced the Zionist attack on the Qatari Reconstruction Committee of Gaza, saying, "Such crimes clearly reveal the Zionists'

barbaric and anti-human nature."

The public conscience has been shocked by the Zionist regime's crimes and barbarism against Gaza and cannot stay silent on this cruelty anymore, he added.

Denouncing the Zionist regime's recurrent and brazen violation of international law and its continued aggression against the people of Palestine, Kanaani called on the international community to

condemn the Zionist crimes and employ all international capacities to hold Israel accountable and prosecute its war criminals.

More than 11,200 Palestinians have been killed in Israeli attacks on Gaza since October 7.

Senior Lawyer Slams Efforts in UK to Blacklist IRGC

TEHRAN - A senior member of Iran's constitutional body the Guardians Council has slammed efforts by members of the parliament in the United Kingdom to designate the Islamic Revolution Guard Corps as a terrorist organization.

Abbasali Kadkhodayi said in a tweet on Tuesday that politicians and the government in the UK needed to change their behavior and stances on issues like terrorism.

"The contradiction in London's Behav & PERF in dealing with HR, democracy, extremism & terrorism is becoming more manifest. Attempts by #UK MPs to designate #IRGC – the military of a SOV state, as a 'terrorist ORG' would have serious consequences. #London should change its Behav," said Kadkhodayi.

The comments came after a group of British parliament members called on the government in London to designate the IRGC as a terrorist organization for what they claimed was IRGC's support for resistance movements in Palestine.

The British government has so far resisted calls for blacklisting the IRGC with authorities warning that the move could have serious regional and international repercussions for the UK.

IRCS: Iranians Donate \$1.74mn in Cash Aid to Gaza

TEHRAN – Head of the volunteers of the Iranian Red Crescent Society (IRCS) Vahid Salimi said on Tuesday that cash donations from Iranians to the Palestinian people of Gaza have reached \$1.74 million at the end of the fifth week of the donation campaign.

The campaign was launched to collect financial aid for the residents of Gaza and the donations have been deposited into the official accounts of the IRCS in the Central Bank of Iran and Bank Melli.

Since the Zionist regime attacked Gaza on October 7, more than 11,000 people, many of them women and children, have lost their lives in the attacks.
