## Gaza Unmasks West's Hypocrisy of Freedom of Expression

*The West's much bandied about claim to 'freedom of expression' which from the beginning was nothing but barely concealed attempts to suppress truth and spread myths, is now fully exposed as sheer hypocrisy as is evident by the blatant backing of Israel's genocide and war crimes in barbarically bombed Gaza by the politicians and the media.*

## In Letter to Heads of 50 Countries, President Raisi Calls for Boycott of Zionist Regime

TEHRAN -- President Ebrahim Raisi said Monday all countries should end commercial and political cooperation with the occupying regime of Israel in an attempt to compel the regime to end its atrocities in the Gaza Strip.

The president made the plea in a letter to the heads of 50 countries, including Russia, China, Turkey, Kazakhstan, South Africa, Kenya and Jordan.

He called on all free and independent countries to use available means, including cutting off trade and political cooperation and communications with Israel, to exert pressure on the regime and play a more prominent role in ending the regime's crimes against Palestinians.

Raisi lashed out at the Zionist regime's brutal acts in massacring thousands of people in

Gaza and destroying the Strip's infrastructure over the past 40 days. He also censured as some Western governments' double standard policies and their deliberate violation of the principles of morality and human rights.

"It is expected that freedom-seeking and independent countries, especially Muslim states adopt a coherent and unified approach in the diplomatic and economic fields to put pressure on this occupying regime," he said.

Such an approach would lay the groundwork for ending the Tel Aviv regime's crimes in killing civilians and removing the siege of Gaza, the president said.

The foreign ministers of Iran and Qatar also said the international community needs to take immediate action to force the Zionist regime to stop its brutal

acts in the Gaza Strip that are in blatant violation of international law.

In a phone conversation on Monday, Iranian Foreign Minister Hussein Amir-Abdollahian and his Qatari counterpart Muhammad bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al Thani, discussed the latest developments in Palestine and Israel's atrocities assault on Gaza.

They emphasized that the Tel Aviv regime is responsible for the ongoing catastrophic situation in the besieged Strip.

The top Iranian and Qatari diplomats also called on Muslim and Arab countries to urgently deliver humanitarian assistance to the oppressed Palestinian people.

Amir-Abdollahian and Al Thani exchanged views about the latest innovative approaches to stop Israel's war crimes in Gaza.

## Iran: Resistance Not to Sit by Idly if Zionist Atrocities Continue

TEHRAN -- Iran said on Monday resistance groups in the region have repeatedly warned the U.S. and Israel that they will not sit idly by if the occupying regime continues its attacks against the Palestinian people in the besieged Gaza Strip.

Speaking at a weekly press conference, Foreign Ministry spokesman Nasser Kanaani said the growing opposition to Israeli crimes in Gaza and the U.S. support for the regime's atrocities show that nations are dissatisfied with the war and want it to stop.

"The actions of the Zionist regime spark a reaction by the resistance groups in the region. They had repeatedly warned the U.S. and the Zionists that if these attacks continue, they will not remain silent," he said.

"The U.S. and the Zionist regime must understand that they can escape the situation only by stopping the war completely and immediately, allowing the dispatch of humanitarian aid, and ending the

forced displacement of the people of Gaza."

Kanaani also urged the U.S. government to pay attention to global security and peace and stop its support for Israeli crimes in Gaza instead of asking others to do or end doing something.

Over the past years, he noted, members of U.S. Congress have demonstrated that they are sacrificing the interests of the American people for those of the Zionist regime.

Kanaani hit out at the "questionable immunity" granted by the U.S. to Israel, saying it enables the regime to prevent the entry of humanitarian assistance to Gaza.

"The Zionist regime has not fulfilled its responsibilities and is preventing the sending of aid. The amount of aid that has entered Gaza is like a drop in the ocean. Only 25 to 40 trucks are allowed to pass borders daily, a number which is very little."

Iran sent relief aid after coordi-

nation with Egypt, but it did not reach Gaza as a result of Israel's non-cooperation with Cairo and international organizations, the spokesman said, adding, however, that Tehran and the Egyptian Red Crescent Society exchange messages on a daily basis.

Kanaani rejected the accusations as a "projection" of blame by the occupying regime of Israel to escape from the dire situation it is facing in Gaza.

"We have repeatedly announced that the resistance groups represent their nations and make decisions and act independently based on the interests of their nations," he said.

"This regime cannot accept that it suffered a multi-dimensional defeat from a Palestinian resistance group in Gaza and it seeks to make accusations against others, including the Islamic Republic of Iran. However, it should know that such allegations are invalid and of no use to the regime."

## Iranian Researchers Develop Rapid Cancer Test Kit

TEHRAN -- Researchers in Iran have successfully developed a cost-effective colorectal cancer screening rapid test kit.

The kit, produced by the Sanje Bio Diagnostic Company, is a significant breakthrough in the diagnosis of colorectal cancer, which is the third

most deadly cancer worldwide, said the managing director of the company.

Hadi Baqeri revealed that the development of the kit began after sanctions led to the cessation of exports of a similar German product to Iran four years ago.

Before the production of this domestic test kit, diagnosing colorectal cancer was not only expensive but also painful, he said, adding the new home-grown test kit, which utilizes nano-technology, has made the process more affordable and less distressing.

The innovation has received a patent from the United States, he said.

He also said that while the price of the kit was \$15, the Iranian researchers have priced their domestically-produced kit at just \$2, making it significantly more accessible.

## 'U.S. Managing Zionist Regime After Hamas Operation'

TEHRAN -- A senior commander of Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) says the United States was forced to prop up the Zionist regime after the occupying regime was defanged at the hands of the Gaza-based Palestinian resistance fighters in their October 7 operation.

Deputy commander of the IRGC's Quds Force Brigadier General Muhammad Reza Fallahzadeh said that Hamas fighters hit the Zionist regime "like lightning" in Operation Al-Aqsa Storm and "humiliated" it after attacking steel forts, concrete walls, and multi-meter-high fences.

"The Palestinian resistance forces shattered the Zionist enemy's grandeur and disrupted and destroyed its intellectual dome in the field of management, thus the U.S. was forced to take over the regime's management," Fallahzadeh said.

He said the Palestinian resistance managed to demolish the Zionist regime's intelligence system, defeat its military, and damage its security.

The IRGC commander also emphasized that the Zionist regime has "achieved nothing" in its heavy aggression, bombings, artillery fire, and direct attacks by tanks and personnel carriers against the besieged Gaza Strip.

The occupying regime is massacring Palestinian people out of "weakness and desperation," he said.

"The enemy fights with the innocent, oppressed people of Gaza and does not dare battle with resistance groups," Fallahzadeh asserted.

"Hamas is indelible and the truth is victorious. It is the falsehood that will be destroyed."

He also said that over the past 75 years, the Zionists have committed crimes in the occupied territories, displaced 7 million defenseless Palestinians, and massacred more than 150,000 people.
