TEHRAN - Iranian players have won five more medals at the 14th World Kurash Wrestling Championship.

Saba Karamali in the women's -78kg and Fatemeh Barmaki in the women's +87kg won two bronze medals.

More than 100 best Kurash players from 12 countries are competing in the tournament in Ashgabat, Turkmenistan.

Team Melli has been drawn in Group F along with Poland, Japan and Germany.

Iran will play Poland at the Jyske Bank Boxen in Herning, Denmark. Iran finished 31st in the previous edition and is going to earn a better place in this edition.

"We are the only women team in Iran to participate in the world championship and this is a great honor. I hope we can show a better performance than the previous edition," Iran's women's team caretaker Elham Solouki said.

Coby White and DeMar DeRozan each tossed in 19 for the Bulls, who have lost their last five games and eight of their last nine. Chicago has also lost its last seven road games.

Boston's Jrue Holiday returned to the court after missing the last two games with an ankle injury, but the Celtics were still without Kristaps Porzingis, who injured his calf in to Orlando and hasn't played since then. Holiday had 14 points, nine assists and seven rebounds.

Chicago's Alex Caruso didn't play in Sunday's loss to Brooklyn because of a toe injury, but he came off the bench to score eight points

The Bulls led 10-8, but the Celtics went on a 17-3 run and led 25-13 following Sam Hauser's 3-pointer with 3:06 remaining in the first quarter. Boston led 31-20 after 12

The Celtics led by 22 points in the second quarter and held a 69-50 advantage at halftime. Boston made 13 of its 24 3-pointers in the half.

Chicago put up little resistance in the third, when Boston's lead ballooned to 32. The Celtics led 97-68 after three quarters, and that lead got as large as 35 points in the

Kashmiri Students Arrested for Celebrating India's Cricket World Cup Defeat

SRINAGAR (Reuters) - Indian police arrested seven students in the Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) region, allegedly celebrating Australia's victory over India in the men's Cricket World Cup final earlier this month, police said on

A senior police official said seven students from an agriculture university were detained last week after a student filed a complaint accusing them of raising anti-India slogans and cheering for Pakistan along with Australia after the match.

Police said the seven students were charged under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) after they found video evidence of them raising anti-India chants. UAPA deals with inciting or advising any unlawful activity and is punishable with seven years' imprisonment.

Man City Claim Top Spot After Recovering to Beat Leipzig 3-2

MANCHESTER (Reuters) - Manchester City's Julian Alvarez scored in the 87th minute as the European champions clawed their way back from two goals down to beat RB Leipzig 3-2 and clinch top spot in Champions League Group G on Tuesday with one round of matches remaining.

Erling Haaland and Phil Foden also netted in the second period after one of City's most underwhelming recent first-half performances to give Pep Guardiola's team 15 points after five games. Leipzig, who had also reached the last 16, have nine.
