Israel's Atomic Arsenal Taboo for IAEA Inspectors

Will the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), which every time raises wild accusations against Iran's internationally confirmed peaceful nuclear programme, ever subject any – if not all – the Israeli nuclear facilities to the inspection and regulation of the global nuclear body?

This is not a million dollar question. Neither is its answer elusive. Nor does the world expect the Vienna-based agency to dare raise this point with Israel.

In short, it will never happen, no matter the magnitude of protests in the Muslim world that the Zionist entity's nuclear arsenal is a threat to the entire region.

The US and the nuclear-powered European states clandestinely provided the atomic energy knowhow to Israel to manufacture bombs more powerful than the Americans had dropped on the Japanese cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945 when Second World War was almost over, and they will ensure that the Zionist entity's doomsday arsenal is outside the inspection of the IAEA.

Moreover, the IAEA's present directors are completely subversive to Israel and act like its agents against the rest of the regional countries, especially vis-à-vis Iran's peaceful nuclear activities, providing all information in violation of international law.

In such a case, no Muslim country stands any chance of convincing the UN and its affiliates, including IAEA, to subject the Israeli nuclear facilities to inspection.

Recently, Qatar's Ministry of Foreign Affairs said in a statement that Doha has appealed to the IAEA to inspect Israel's nuclear facilities.

At a session of the UN atomic agency on Saturday, Qatar's Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the United Nations Office and International Organizations in Vienna, Jassim Yaqoub al-Hammadi, also urged the Tel Aviv regime to sign the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT).

He underscored the need for the international community and its institutions to uphold their commitments under resolutions of the UN Security Council, the UN General Assembly, the IAEA, and the 1995 Review Conference of the NPT, which called on Israel to subject all its nuclear facilities to IAEA safeguards."

The US, Israel, and West European regime are probably laughing at these demands, however, justified. They will never allow the IAEA to entertain any such idea.

According to experts, the illegal Zionist entity has around 400 nuclear warheads in its arsenal, making it the sole possessor of non-conventional arms in West Asia.

It has refused to either allow inspections of its nuclear facilities by the IAEA or sign the NPT.

The only solution for Israel's nuclear disarmament is coordinated destruction of its doomsday arsenal, provided the Muslim world is ready to unite and take decisive action.

Parliament Speaker Muhammad Bagher Ghalibaf: Iran Will Not Wait for Any U.S. Letter

TEHRAN -- Parliament speaker Muhammad Bagher Ghalibaf said Sunday that Iran will not wait for any letter from the United States as the country relies on its domestic capacities.

Ghalibaf made the remarks during an open parliamentary session on Sunday, two days after U.S. President Donald Trump claimed in an interview with Fox News that he had sent a letter to Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei.

Trump said he had warned Iran to open talks on a nuclear deal or be handled militarily.

"We will not await any letter from the U.S. and believe that by using the enormous domestic capacities and the opportunities for developing foreign relations with other countries, we can reach a position that leaves the enemy with no choice but to lift sanctions within the framework of continuing negotiations with the remaining parties to the JCPOA," Ghalibaf said.

He was referring to the 2015 nuclear deal, known as the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action, which Trump abandoned in 2018.

Ghalibaf said Trump's behavior towards other countries shows that

his calls for talks are merely a "deception" meant to "disarm" Iran.

He said negotiations, accompanied by threats, humiliation, and demands for new concessions, will not lead to the removal of sanctions.

"Today, more than ever, it has become clear to the honorable Iranian nation that the lifting of sanctions is possible through strengthening Iran and neutralizing the bans," he added.

Speaking on Saturday, the Leader said the insistence of some bullying powers on holding talks with Iran does not aim to solve issues but to assert their expectations.

Ministry: Canada's Sanctions Against Iran 'Deceitful'

TEHRAN – Iran on Sunday strongly denounced Canadian sanctions against the Islamic Republic as "deceitful" and "in violation of international law."

In a statement, Assistant to Foreign Minister and Director General for the Americas Department at the Iranian Foreign Ministry Issa Kameli said the move is unlawful, illegitimate, and a violation of the human rights of the Iranian people, making the Canadian government internationally accountable.

"The new sanctions imposed by Canada against Iran under the pretext of human rights are a political and deceitful move that contradicts the principles of the United Nations Charter and international laws governing free trade between countries," the statement read.

Canada announced on Friday fresh anti-Iran sanctions targeting

seven individuals and entities over their alleged links to networks involved in the production of weapons, which Ottawa claims to have been sent to Russia for use in the Ukraine war.

The Canadian government also justified the sanctions by citing Iran's purported role in "gross human rights violations" and destabilizing activities.

The Canadian Foreign Ministry said the new sanctions align with measures taken by Canada's allies, including the United States, the United Kingdom, and the European Union.

Kameli pointed out that Canada itself is among the major violators of human rights, including through its complicity and deliberate participation in the genocide of the Palestinian people in the Gaza Strip.

He called upon Canada to take

responsibility for its complicity in Israel's genocide and war crimes against the Palestinian people, as well as other human rights abuses.

Responding to repeated accusations regarding Iran's alleged involvement in the Ukraine conflict, the senior diplomat vehemently denied these claims and emphasized that "repeating a lie does not make it true."

He reiterated Iran's position of non-involvement in the ongoing Russia-Ukraine crisis, underscoring the country's opposition to war and advocating for diplomatic negotiations as the means to resolve disputes between warring parties.

The diplomat further advised Canadian officials to focus on addressing their own domestic and international shortcomings, particularly the systemic policy of the

Gen. Bagheri: Trump's Gaza Plan a Non-Starter

TEHRAN – Chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Major General Muhammad Hussein Bagheri dismissed the U.S. president's plan for the relocation of Palestinians from the Gaza Strip as impractical.

Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of a meeting with Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei here Saturday, the top Iranian general rejected Donald Trump's push for the relocation of Gazans is an "unworkable" plan based on sensational comments.

The ones who have occupied Palestine must leave, the commander said, stressing that the Palestinian nation has its roots in Palestine and will remain in its own territory.

Asked about the Trump administration's policies against Iran, General Bagheri said the enemies have been applying the policy of maximum pressure on Iran for years.

He stated that the Iranian nation stands firmly although the enemies have imposed all types of sanctions against Iran.

Commenting on the Lebanese Hezbollah's conditions, the general emphasized that the young forces of Hezbollah will definitely grow.

Ex-Fox News Host Blasts U.S. Threats Against Iran

WASHINGTON (Dispatches) -- Former Fox News host Tucker Carlson has censured the anti-Iran rhetoric propagated by U.S. politicians and news outlets for laying the groundwork for Washington to launch a war against the Islamic Republic.

In a post on X on Sunday, Carlson said the constant portrayal of Iran as a "sponsor of terror" is an attempt to manipulate public opinion in favor of military action against the Islamic Republic.

"Fox News is wall to wall with dead-eyed politicians telling you that Iran is a dangerous 'sponsor of terror.' Softening

up the base for a war," Carlson wrote.

The American political commentator, close to U.S. President Donald Trump, then went on to compare the risk posed by Iran in comparison to other elements threatening the people of the United States.

"Over the past twenty years, how many Americans have been killed by Iran on American soil in the past twenty years?"

He urged people to research this number and compare it to the number of Americans killed by other causes, such as drug overdoses, suicide, illegal aliens,
