Interim FM Bagheri Kani on CNN Turk:

Iran to Put Zionists in Their Place if Needed

ISTANBUL (Dispatches) --Iran's interim foreign minister says the Islamic Republic will not hesitate to employ its deterrence power in case Israel undermines regional security and stability.

In an interview with CNN Turk, Ali Bagheri Kani said the Zionists are well aware that Iran will "wisely" and "effectively" use its power to "put them in their place."

"The Zionists' airstrike on the consular section of the Iranian embassy in the Syrian capital Damascus prompted the country to effectively and wisely utilize its power components in order to ensure the security and stability of the region," Bagheri Kani said.

"I think the Zionists know very well that in case they try to destabilize the region and undermine its security, Iran will use its might to contain them and put them in their place," he added.

Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) launched missile and drone strikes on Israeli-occupied territories on April 13 in retaliation for an April 1 attack on the Iranian IAEA," Bagheri Kani noted. consulate in Damascus.

Bagheri Kani urged Muslim countries to halt all political and economic cooperation with

the Zionist regime and impose a mass boycott on Israeli prod-

Such measures would be the most effective means for Muslim nations to demonstrate solidarity with the Palestinian cause, and oppose Israeli policies, he said.

Commenting on escalating tensions between Russia and the West, Bagheri Kani said there is a need for dialogue between the two sides to resolve the differences.

He rejected the notion of a military confrontation, saying, "We do not see a war as a solution to the problem. Our advice to both sides is to use dialogue in a political context."

The senior Iranian diplomat also pointed to Tehran's civilian nuclear program, stressing that the Islamic Republic's atomic program is in strict accordance with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) requirements and international treaties.

"Iran's nuclear program and activities are fully legal and under the supervision of the

On Wednesday, the IAEA's Board of Governors passed a resolution against Iran during its meeting, despite warnings

from Tehran that it would react decisively to such a measure.

The resolution, supported and put forward by Britain, France and Germany, urged Iran to cooperate more with the IAEA and to allow an increased number of inspectors to visit nuclear sites in the country.

Tehran "rejected all the allegations" in the E3's letter and "reiterated its position concerning its peaceful nuclear program and the JCPOA."

Separately, Bagheri Kani said the occupying regime of Israel has "no qualms" about committing the most serious international crimes against Palestinians during its "full-scale Gaza genocide."

"Over the past eight months, the Islamic Republic of Iran has been one of the loudest voices against the Zionist regime's bloodshed against the oppressed people of Palestine and has tried to stop this invasion and genocide as soon as possible," he wrote in an opinion piece in the Turkish Milliyet newspaper.

He also expressed regret that the international community has failed to take an effective measure against the occupying regime's heinous atrocities, (Continued on Page 7)

Flight Models of Kowsar, Hodhold **Satellites Unveiled**

TEHRAN -- Iran on Sunday unveiled flight models of the homegrown Kowsar and Hodhod satellites.

The models were put on show at a ceremony here, where the active professionals of the private sector had gathered to honor the endeavors of late President Ebrahim Raisi in the space field.

The Kowsar satellite is expected to be placed at a distance of 500 kilometers from the Earth's surface this autumn aboard the Russian rocket Soyuz.

It can be used for agricultural, mapping and demarcation purposes.

The satellite is equipped with two cameras and can take images with a resolution of 3.45 meters.
