# Russia's State Duma Approves 20-Year Strategic Partnership Treaty With Iran

TEHRAN - Russia's lower house of parliament has ratified a comprehensive strategic partnership treaty with Iran, marking a significant step in the expansion of political, military, and economic relations between Moscow and Tehran.

Lawmakers in the State Duma approved the 20-year treaty on Tuesday.

President Vladimir Putin of Russia and Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian signed the agreement in Moscow in January. Putin submitted it to the State Duma in March.

When the treaty was signed in January, the Russian leader said it was a "breakthrough document," and the Iranian president said it would "open a new chapter in relations between Iran and Russia in all fields."

It provides the legal framework for the long-term development of cooperation in areas ranging from

defense, energy, finances, and transportation to industries, agriculture, culture, science, and technology.

Based on the treaty, Russia and Iran are committed to helping each other counter common "security threats" and exchange intelligence in that direction.

The agreement also stipulates that if either side is subjected to aggression, the other will not provide "assistance to the aggressor."

Russian Deputy Foreign Minister Andrei Rudenko said in an address to the State Duma, "The signing of the treaty does not mean the establishment of a military alliance with Iran or mutual military assistance."

The Russia-Iran treaty promotes investment in oil and gas development, joint long-term projects in peaceful nuclear energy, and the creation of a payment system independent of third countries, which uses national currencies.

State Duma Chairman Vyacheslav Volodin said earlier that the treaty would strengthen relations in terms of both bilateral cooperation and coordination on international issues.

He said the agreement underscores the expansion of inter-parliamentary relations, including within international parliamentary organizations and through the commission on cooperation between the State Duma and the Parliament of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Iran and Russia, as two close and strategic allies, have over the past years deepened relations in various fields, despite heavy Western sanctions.

The Kremlin's spokesman, Dmitry Peskov, has said Moscow is in continuous consultations with Tehran and is ready to take necessary steps to resolve tensions between the U.S. and Iran through "political and diplomatic avenues."

## War With Iran Would Be 'Suicidal', Tucker Carlson Warns U.S. Neocons

TEHRAN— Former Fox News host Tucker Carlson has warned that war with Iran would be "suicidal," saying that anyone advocating for it is an "enemy" of the United States.

In a post on X on Tuesday, Carlson said the U.S. cannot afford such war, as a result of which, he warned, "Thousands of Americans would die."

"Whatever you think of tariffs, it's clear that now is the worst possible time for the United States to participate in a military strike on Iran," he said.

He further said that even though the U.S. is sure to lose the war that follows an attack against Iran, "yet we're closer than ever to war, thanks to unrelenting pressure from neocons."

"This is suicidal," warned Carlson, an avid supporter of U.S. President Donald Trump. "Anyone advocating for conflict with Iran is not an ally of the United States, but an enemy."

Tensions have skyrocketed between the two countries in recent weeks, especially after Trump warned that there would

be "bombing" against Iran if it refused to negotiate with the United States over its nuclear program.

Iran has categorically dismissed the idea of holding direct talks with the United States, given Washington's illegal withdrawal from the 2015 Iran deal during the first Trump administration. However, the two sides are slated to hold indirect talks in Oman on Saturday, in what Tehran has described as a "test" and an "opportunity" for Washington.

## Road Minister Meets Azerbaijani President in Baku

TEHRAN - Minister of Roads and Urban Development of the Islamic Republic of Iran Farzaneh Sadeq, who is in Baku for a three-day trip, has met with President of Azerbaijan Ilham Aliyev.

Aliyev welcomed the growing frequency of high-level visits between the two countries, describing them as "a good opportunity to strengthen friendship" and expand cooperation in sectors such as trade, energy and transport.

The Azerbaijani leader also praised the timing and agenda of the Azerbaijan-Iran Joint Intergovernmental Commission on Economic Cooperation, held during Sadiq's visit, pointing to its role

in supporting strategic projects.

Iran minister Sadeq conveyed Pezeshkian's greetings to Aliyev and reaffirmed Iran's interest in advancing cooperation with Azerbaijan, citing deep-rooted historical, cultural, religious and kinship ties between the two peoples.

"The holding of this Commission meeting before President Pezeshkian's visit is extremely important for discussing major issues," she said.

The two sides also discussed the North-South transport corridor and the planned construction of a road bridge across the Araz River linking Aghbend and Kalale, as well as other mutual initiatives.

## IRGC Equips 'Gaza Drone' With Anti-Jamming Gear

TEHRAN – The Islamic Revolution Guards Corps Aerospace Force has equipped its wide-body combat drone "Gaza" with anti-jamming and anti-spoofing devices.

A series of Iranian weapons were exhibited in the LAAD (Latin America Aerospace and Defense) 2025 in Brazil.

The 15th edition of the trade show was held in Rio de Janeiro from April 1 to 4.

It was the first time the Iranian Defense Ministry was attending the event.

In its pavilion, Iran showcased a replica of the homegrown Shahed-149 (aka Gaza) wide-body military drone.

Images of the product indicate that the drone has been furnished with new antennas and navigation receivers designed to prevent or mitigate the effects of radio frequency jamming in electronic warfare.

Such anti-jamming and anti-spoofing equipment had already proved successful in Shahed-129 drones.

Known as Iran's biggest combat drone, Shahed-149 was unveiled in May 2021. Powered by a turboprop engine, the military UAV is capable of carrying 13 bombs.

With a wingspan of 21 meters, Gaza weighs 3.1 tons and can carry a payload of 500 kilograms.

the UN workers that are involved in humanitarian activities amid the armed clashes.

He also stressed the need to observe and protect the treaties, rules and norms of the international humanitarian law, including the protection of medical personnel, facilities, and transports during armed conflicts.
