Pezeshkian Urges Decisive Response to Israeli Atrocities in Talks With Guterres

TEHRAN -- In a series of high-level diplomatic engagements during his official visit to China, Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian met with UN chief António Guterres and key regional leaders, reaffirming Iran's commitment to peace, regional stability, and international cooperation amid ongoing geopolitical tensions.

During the pivotal meeting with Guterres, President Pezeshkian emphasized Iran's long-standing dedication to peace and stability in West Asia, condemning the aggressive actions of the Israeli regime.

"It is important to clarify that the war was imposed upon us by the Zionist regime," Pezeshkian stated, expressing appreciation for the UN chief's previous remarks condemning Israeli crimes against Palestinians in Gaza and Iran itself.

However, he called for more decisive and explicit international responses to the ongoing atrocities,

urging the United Nations and other global organizations to take concrete steps to halt the escalating violence.

Highlighting the ongoing security challenges faced by Iran, President Pezeshkian underscored that Iran remains one of the main victims of terrorism, with numerous officials and dignitaries lost to such acts.

He stressed that the Zionist regime continues to conduct extrajudicial assassinations across the region under the guise of self-defense, destabilizing peace and security.

Addressing the controversial role of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), Pezeshkian voiced strong criticism of the agency's reluctance to condemn Israeli strikes on Iran's peaceful nuclear facilities, which operate under strict international oversight.

He cited the recent parliamentary decision to suspend coopera-

tion with the IAEA as a response to these untrustworthy actions but reiterated Iran's preference for diplomatic dialogue.

"We have entrusted the Supreme National Security Council with decisions on cooperation to ensure constructive engagement," the president noted, affirming Iran's continued pursuit of peaceful nuclear development.

Guterres expressed his personal conviction that Iran's nuclear program is peaceful and that Tehran has no intention of developing nuclear weapons.

He acknowledged Iran's right to peaceful nuclear technology and voiced concern over the activation of the "snapback" mechanism under the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA), encouraging European partners to engage constructively with Iran.

Officials Stress SCO's Role Against Western Overreach, Sanctions

TEHRAN — Iran's Defense Minister Brigadier General Aziz Nasirzadeh on Monday described the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) summit as a significant platform to counteract Western unilateralism and economic domination.

Speaking on the sidelines of the summit in China, Nasirzadeh, who accompanied President Masoud Pezeshkian on his visit to Beijing, emphasized that the world today faces "unilateralism and overreach by the West in security, economic,

and political spheres."

"The SCO and similar alliances like BRICS offer appropriate alternatives to confront this one-sided approach," Nasirzadeh stated. He underscored the importance of forging new coalitions to enhance cooperation among nations, bolster regional security, and develop economies resilient to sanctions.

"The formation of new economic and security coalitions enables countries to collaborate in securing their regions while developing

their economies to withstand sanctions," he added. "The SCO was established with these objectives and has already yielded positive results."

The remarks came as President Pezeshkian led a high-level delegation to the SCO and Shanghai Plus summits in Tianjin, China. The delegation included key ministers from defense, economy, and foreign affairs.

Iranian officials stress the strategic

Iran Condemns 'Unprecedented' Israeli Crime Against Yemen

TEHRAN -- Iran has strongly condemned the recent Israeli airstrike in Yemen that killed Yemeni Prime Minister Ahmed Ghalib al-Rahwi, Foreign Minister Jamal Ameri, and several senior officials.

Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi and Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces Major General Abdulrahman Mousavi released statements denouncing the attack as a "brutal and unprecedented crime" against the Yemeni people and a violation of international law.

Araghchi expressed "deep sorrow and grief" over the assassination and extended con-

lences "to the heroic people of Yemen, the oppressed Palestinian nation, and all freedom-loving peoples of the world."

He described the strike as a "cowardly assassination" that violated Yemen's sovereignty and territorial integrity, carried out amid "savage military aggression of the Zionist regime."

He further criticized the United Nations for its "continued inaction in the face of gross violations of international law by the Zionist regime," and condemned the "military and political support provided by the U.S., the UK, and some Western countries," which "has severely

undermined the credibility of fundamental international legal norms and turned these countries into accomplices and partners in the crimes of the occupying regime."

"This situation is an unprecedented threat to international peace and security and poses an existential danger to humanity," Araghchi warned.

He urged regional states and the international community to "take urgent and effective action to stop the genocide in Gaza and hold the leaders of the Zionist regime accountable."

Major General Mousavi called

Joint Iran, Russia, China Letter Condemns European Sanctions Bid

TEHRAN — Iran, Russia, and China have jointly written to the United Nations Secretary-General and the Security Council to denounce recent European efforts to reactivate the controversial "snapback" sanctions mechanism.

The trio strongly argued that those states failing to meet their obligations have no right to benefit from agreements they themselves have undermined.

Iran's Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi shared the joint letter on his official X account, emphasizing the legal and political flaws of the European move.

"Our joint letter with my colleagues, the Foreign Ministers of China and Russia, signed in Tianjin reflects the firm position that the European attempt to invoke 'snapback' is legally baseless and politically destructive," Araghchi wrote.

The letter underscores that the U.S. was the first party to violate the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) and UN Security Council Resolution 2231, while European countries subsequently chose to align themselves with unlawful sanctions rather than uphold their own commitments.

"By declaring the E3's move null and void, we have placed on record that no party can erase the sequence of events: it was the United States that first violated the JCPOA and Resolution 2231, and it was Europe that subsequently chose to align with unlawful sanctions instead of honoring its own commitments," Araghchi explained.

Highlighting a core principle of international law, the letter stresses: "Rights and obligations cannot be separated. States that fail to fulfill their own commitments cannot claim the benefits of an agreement they have undermined."

The statement reinforces the importance of credibility in multilateral diplomacy, warning that selective compliance and procedural misuse threaten the very foundations of international collective security.

The letter also critiques the European trio's approach as detrimental
