## In the Name of the Most High Viewpoint

### The Only Way to End Israel's Aggression

*Whatever the contents of the communique to be released at the end of the extraordinary meeting of heads of states of Arab and other Muslim countries in Qatar on confronting Israel's expanding aggression in the region, the underlying truth is that West Asia will never be a secure place for its people unless the illegal Zionist entity is weeded out.*

## President Pezeshkian, PM Sudan Demand: Urgent Need for Practical Measures to Stop Israel

TEHRAN/DOHA -- Iran's President Masoud Pezeshkian and Iraqi Prime Minister Muhammad Shia al-Sudani emphasized the urgent need for a unified stance among Islamic countries to take practical steps to stop Israeli crimes and prevent their recurrence, following Israel's recent aggression in the region.

Speaking on the sidelines of the emergency summit of Islamic countries and the Arab League in Doha, Pezeshkian highlighted the necessity of solidarity among Muslim nations to counter Israel's actions.

"If all Islamic countries join hands, Zionists will not dare commit such crimes against any of the Islamic countries," he said.

Pezeshkian described the ongoing violence in Gaza as intolerable, condemning Israel's "continuous bombings against defenseless people" and the starvation of children, women, and men.

He stressed that Muslims must act as

"a united hand" to halt the brutality. "I have always declared since my election campaign that I seek to strengthen unity and cohesion in my country and among Islamic countries," Pezeshkian added.

He said Israel is committing atrocities with the backing of the United States and European countries.

"This regime would not have dared to commit such crimes without American and European support," he said.

Pezeshkian also criticized the hypocrisy of Western diplomacy, pointing to Israel's attacks during peace talks: "Israel targeted the resistance summit in the midst of reviewing U.S. peace proposals, which shows the falsity of U.S. and Western claims about diplomacy and human rights."

Prime Minister al-Sudani echoed calls for collective Islamic action, stressing that a unified position must go beyond declarations. "This situation requires Islamic countries to coordi-

nate more closely and use all available tools and capabilities for serious practical measures to stop these crimes," he said.

Al-Sudani urged maintaining momentum from the recent surge of solidarity following Israel's attack in Qatar, advocating for continuous communication to build a "common Islamic-Arab position and the foundation for serious action and alliance."

He warned against limiting efforts to "holding meetings and issuing statements," emphasizing the need to harness "all capacities and capabilities to stop the practical crimes of the Zionist regime."

Sudani said he is seriously pursuing the diplomatic process between Iran, the United States, and European countries, adding: "The more open and active the diplomatic window remains, the less opportunity leaders like Netanyahu will have to impose their narratives on the world."

### Iran Urges Muslim States to Cut Ties With Zionist Regime

TEHRAN/DOHA – Iran on Monday called on Islamic countries to take concrete and practical steps, including suspending diplomatic and economic relations with Israel, following an emergency summit held in Doha to address the Zionist regime's recent military aggression in the region.

Ismail Baghaei, spokesman for Iran's Foreign Ministry, who attended the summit as part of the Iranian delegation, told media that the public in the region and worldwide "naturally expects a series of practical steps."

"Perhaps the first of these would

be at least suspending diplomatic and economic relations of Islamic countries with the Zionist regime," he added.

The emergency summit of Islamic and Arab leaders was convened in Qatar in response to Israeli strikes targeting the Qatari capital Doha. The gathering brought together presidents, prime ministers, and foreign ministers from many Muslim countries, underscoring the seriousness with which the region views the growing threat posed by Israel's actions.

Baghaei described the summit as

"a significant step" that reflects the regional awareness of the dangers of Israeli aggression and expansionism.

The meeting began on Sunday with a ministerial session during which Qatar's prime minister and foreign minister condemned Israel's attacks on Doha. Baghaei said they emphasized that the strikes were "unprecedented and very dangerous" and "contrary to all norms and rules of international law."

During the session, a draft declaration was circulated among

### Israel Convicts Ultra-Orthodox Man of Spying for Iran

TEL AVIV (Dispatches) -- An Israeli court has convicted 22-year-old Elimelech Stern, an ultra-orthodox Haredi yeshiva student from Bet Shemesh near Al-Quds, of "spying for Iran".

Israeli media reported that Stern was found guilty of "contact with a foreign agent" and "conspiring to make threats" after communicating with someone online—accused by Israel of being linked to Iranian intelligence—in exchange for cryptocurrency.

During interrogations conducted by Shin Bet, the Israeli regime's notorious internal security agency, Stern reportedly

admitted to communicating with a Telegram user under the alias "Anna Elena."

However, he later told the court he had no knowledge that the contact was with a foreign actor and that his legal rights were grossly violated during the investigation, requesting that his testimony be dismissed. Despite this, the court refused to dismiss the testimony.

According to judge Hannah Miriam Lump, Stern had involved two others in actions allegedly directed by his online contact. These included posting fliers in Tel Aviv carrying the message:

"It will be written in history that children were killed, let's stand on the right side of history"—a clear reference to Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza and broader crimes across the region.

The accomplice took photos of himself hanging the fliers in Tel Aviv in early June 2024 and sent them to Stern, who then forwarded them to the agent, the report said.

Stern was also accused of planning to leave a symbolic package outside the home of Ronen Shaul, Israel's representative to the IAEA, though this alleged act was never carried out.

### Defense Minister: Unipolar World a Global Conspiracy

TEHRAN -- Iran's Defense Minister Major General Aziz Nasirzadeh said on Monday that the world remains in flux as it struggles to establish a new global order following the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1990.

Speaking at the opening ceremony of the 7th International Peace and Defense Book Exhibition here, Nasirzadeh said ongoing conflicts reflect the failure of attempts to impose a unipolar system.

"After the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1990, the bipolar world order dissolved, and the world is now in turmoil trying to establish a new system," Nasirzadeh said.

He noted that various theories for a new order — including multipolar, unipolar, and hybrid models — have been proposed, but "the wars we have witnessed in Afghanistan, Iraq, Ukraine, and the Middle East, including Syria and the repeated attacks by the Zionist regime, stem from efforts to enforce a unipolar world."

Nasirzadeh described the unipolar order as "a conspiracy against the world," rather than a means to maintain global stability. "This system is not about establishing order but about conspiracy, and the world will not accept it, even from countries that claim to be allies or act in the name of global peace," he said.

He touched on the ideological arrogance of the proponents of unipolarity, citing Israel as an example of a regime that claims superiority and denies rights to others.

"The Zionist regime says we are the superior creation and that others were created to serve us," Nasirzadeh said, citing Israel's narrow definition of human rights that excludes Palestinians.

Nasirzadeh also condemned economic warfare tactics such as tariff conflicts, labeling them tools used by the unipolar system to dominate and exploit other nations.

"The mistaken belief that countries can be subjugated through economic wars to plunder their resources will not be accepted by the world," he added.

The exhibition, held at Tehran's Army Command and Staff University, also featured remarks from
