Iran Claim World Wrestling **Championship Title**



TEHRAN - Iran's National Freestyle Wrestling team has claimed the championship title at the 2025 World Wrestling Championships in Zagreb, Croatia, marking its first triumph in 12

The decisive moment came on Monday night when Amirhossein Firouzpour secured a bronze medal in the 92kg category. The freestyle wrestler from Iran's northern province of Mazandaran defeated Kazakhstan's Kamil Kurugliev 4–0, sealing Iran's overall victory. Firouzpour already defeated Batyrbek Tsakulov of Slovakia 7-2 in the quarterfinals to advance to the semifinals.

Firouzpour's bronze was the team's seventh medal in Zagreb,

following one gold, three silvers, and two other bronzes. This latest achievement marks Iran's sixth world title since the country's first championship win in 1961. The 2025 championships run from September 13-21.

President Masoud Pezeshkian congratulated the national team, praising the victory as a source of pride and joy for the Iranian nation. In his message on Monday night, he highlighted the wrestlers' tireless efforts, saying the win proved that the sons and daughters of this land, as always, "are capable of raising the proud flag of the Islamic Republic of Iran in the toughest arenas of the

Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi also extended his congratulations, expressing hope for further achievements by Iranian athletes on the global stage.

Volleyballers Edge Tunisia at World Championship

Poriya Hussein Khanzadeh scored 21 points for Iran, and captain Morteza Sharifi earned 18 points.

Team Melli are scheduled to play the Philippines on Thursday.

Italy are the defending champion, having won its fourth title in 2022.

Taking place in Manila, Philippines, the championship features 32 teams from across the world competing for the coveted title, divided into eight pools of four teams, where the top two advance to the knockout stage.


Persepolis Eye Spanish Player Sergio Reguilon




have entered into negotiations with these Spanish players.

Reguilón is a graduate of Real Madrid's youth academy. He made his senior debut in August 2015, while on loan at Logroñés. Reguilón made his first-team debut for Real Madrid in October 2018. He spent the 2019-20 season on loan at Sevilla, where he won the UEFA Europa League and was named in the Squad of the Season. Reguilón signed for Tottenham Hotspur in September 2020.
