Verdict of Aban 13 Rallies

Yesterday's chants of God's Majesty (Allah-o-Akbar) along with the slogans of "marg bar Amrika" (death to the US) and "marg bar Israel" (death to Israel) were so vociferous throughout the country in some 900 cities and towns that the reverberation ricocheting off the mountain tops, the sea surface, and the desert sands likely transcended the political and geographical barriers.

IRGC Vows Heavier Losses on Enemies in Case of Aggression

TEHRAN – IRGC spokesperson General Ali Muhammad Naeini highlighted Iran's growing military preparedness, warning the enemies that they will have to suffer heavier defeats in case of any aggression against the country.

"Today the country is safer, military preparedness is greater and deterrence is increasing. The enemy's weaknesses are more apparent and we are ready for inflicting heavier defeats (on enemies)," Naeini said on Tuesday.

He made the remarks at a rally marking the National Day of Fighting against Global Arrogance in Karaj.

Referring to the 12-day war imposed by the Israeli regime and the U.S. in June, the spokesman said the war was an American project, commissioned by the U.S. and executed by the Zionist regime. "Iran stood alone against the entire NATO and CENTCOM, and the enemy suffered a heavy defeat," he said.

"The 12-day war showed that

American statesmen are not trustworthy, and the Iranian people were tactically aware and, through solidarity, became a steel shield," General Naeini emphasized.

He then warned that the enemy's post-war focus is on undermining national cohesion.

"The enemy's strategy is to construct a narrative of victory from the previous war and to produce fear of a new war, targeting the economy, political stability, and the public's morale in order to make Iran anxious and despondent," he cautioned.

Earlier, chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Major General Abdolrahim Mousavi expressed satisfaction with the increasing defensive deterrent power, emphasizing that Iran's combat readiness has prevented enemies from conducting a new round of strikes against the country.

"Our defensive and combat preparedness has reached a stage that prevents enemies from committing miscalculations, including

the notion of launching a fresh invasion of our country," Mousavi said.

The high-ranking military commander praised the comprehensive preparedness of the Iranian armed forces to vigorously defend the country's independence, security, and territorial integrity, and to confront all potential threats and dangers.

Mousavi also appreciated the vigilance and wisdom of the armed forces and lauded their historic experiences, particularly the 1980-88 war imposed by then-Iraqi dictator Saddam Hussein and the 12-day Israeli-U.S. war in June.

On June 13, the Zionist regime launched an unprovoked war of aggression against Iran, targeting military, nuclear, and residential areas for 12 consecutive days. The United States later escalated the conflict by striking three of Iran's nuclear sites in Natanz, Fordow, and Isfahan on June 22.

Gov't Spokesperson: Iran Will Never Pursue Nuclear Weapons

TEHRAN – Administration spokesperson Fatemeh Mohajerani says Iran will never pursue nuclear weapons based on cultural, religious, and ethical principles.

During her weekly press conference on Tuesday, Mohajerani highlighted the recent remarks made by Rafael Grossi, the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), regarding Iran's nuclear activities, saying "Grossi emphasized that Iran has never had, and does

not have, a military nuclear program."

She added, "There are three fundamental reasons why we will never pursue the development of a nuclear bomb. First, our cultural and historical foundation is incompatible with such a course of action. Second, our religious beliefs, which are grounded in an explicit fatwa (religious decree) that declares the production and use of nuclear weapons to be Haram (religiously forbidden). Third,

the ethical foundation of the Iranian nation is rooted in principles of humanity and ethical conduct."

The Islamic Republic's cooperation with the IAEA is carried out under the guidance of the Supreme National Security Council (SNSC), ensuring that all actions align with the nation's interests, Mohajerani said.

She emphasized that there are total consensus and coordination between the administration and Parliament in this regard.

Pakistan, Iran Using Joint Capabilities to Counter Western, Israeli Threats

TEHRAN - Iran's and Pakistan's defense and military capabilities are "complementary," a senior Iranian military delegate stresses, saying both countries pledge to boost their alliance to counter and tackle Western and Israeli threats.

Captain Darioush Eskandari made the remarks on the second day of the Pakistan International Maritime Expo & Conference (PIMEC 2025) in Karachi on Tuesday, calling for closer cooperation to strengthen deterrence.

The head of Iran's military delegation stressed that the defense and military capabilities of the two neighboring countries complement each other, emphasizing

that this opportunity should be used to reap mutual benefits and address shared challenges.

"It has been a valuable opportunity to participate in the International Maritime Expo & Conference in our eastern neighbor, Pakistan. Fortunately, the level and quality of the industries and products presented by the Islamic Republic of Iran's Defense Ministry are highly satisfactory and impressive," Eskandari further said.

He added that foreign officials from countries participating in the exhibition, as well as senior Pakistani authorities, including the commander of the Pakistan Navy, visited Iran's pavilion.

"The expansion of defense and military cooperation with the friendly and neighboring country of Pakistan will be highly effective in strengthening the deterrent power of the Islamic Republic of Iran. The transfer of technology and experience, along with cooperation in the educational field, also serves the mutual interests of both nations," Eskandari stressed.

During their meetings with Iranian officials and experts, visitors became acquainted with Iran's military achievements in various fields, he noted.

immediate and forceful response. The IRGC Aerospace Force carried out 22 waves of retaliatory missile strikes under Operation True Promise III, inflicting significant damage and heavy losses on cities across the occupied territories.

In retaliation for the U.S. attacks, Iranian forces also targeted al-Udeid Air Base in Qatar —the largest American military installation in West Asia— with a barrage of missiles.

The confrontation came to an end on June 24, when a ceasefire was enforced.

Unauthentic Comments on Iran's Arms Trade Denied

TEHRAN – The General Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces dismissed as unauthentic the remarks attributed to uninformed individuals about Iran's military and defense cooperation with other countries, including stories about the purchase or sale of weapons.

"Following comments made by some uninformed and unauthorized individuals that have no responsibility in the Armed Forces, the Public Relations Center of the General Staff of the Armed Forces announces that any statements regarding military and defense cooperation with other countries, including the purchase or sale of equipment and weaponry, are without validity or credibility," a statement released on Tuesday said.

"All media outlets are expected to refrain from publishing or disseminating such news and information without coordination with this Center," it added.
