The Message for Tyrants of
the Massive Arba’een Rallies

While Karbala hosted some 25 million pilgrims this year for the Arba’een of Imam Husain (AS), with the largest multimillion march covering the 87-km highway from Holy Najaf, the Iranian capital registered the second largest pilgrim rally on the 40th day of the martyrdom of Prophet Muhammad’s (SAWA) grandson.

Yesterday Tehran witnessed millions of black-clad mourners for the annual walk on Safar 20 from the Imam Husain (AS) Square in the city centre to the shrine of Seyyed Abdul-Azeem some 20 km south.

These massive gatherings echoed with elegies for the immortal martyrs of Karbala, along with vows of vengeance for the innocent blood of Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei (RA) and other martyrs of the US-Israeli imposed war, including the 168 schoolchildren of Minab.

Another common feature of the Arba’een assemblies held in all other towns and cities of the Islamic Republic were, in addition to the huge portraits of Martyr Ayatollah Khamenei (RA), large posters of the other martyrs, especially of Iran’s Qasim Soleimani and Iraq’s Abu Mahdi al-Muhandis.

These two generals of the anti-terrorism campaign were the victims of the dastardly dotard Donald Trump, whom both the Iranian and Iraqi people have pledged to punish.

People in the two said countries are confident of bringing to justice the criminal US president. They note that the sacred blood of Imam Husain (AS) was avenged within a few years by Mukhtar ibn Abu Obeidah Thaqafi who traced, tracked down, tried and threw into the bowels of Hell most of the cowardly killers of the Prophet’s Blessed Household.

IRGC Commander: Iran Has
Total Intelligence Superiority
in Northwestern Part

TEHRAN – A senior commander said that Iran has achieved “total intelligence superiority” in the northwest, and warned enemies against any “miscalculation” in the region. Brigadier General Muhammad Karami, commander of the Ground Force of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC), said on Monday during a visit to northwestern Iran that the forces stationed in the operational areas of the region “are prepared to confront any miscalculation by enemies and the leaders and members

of terrorist groups.”

He said the forces of the Hamzeh Seyed al-Shohada Base have gained valuable experience through years of defending Iran’s territory. They, the commander stated, enjoy a combination of faith, modern technology and scientific capabilities to enhance their readiness.

The IRGC commander warned that the Iranian forces are prepared to “turn this land into a mass graveyard for malicious elements and mercenaries.”

Leader’s Advisor: Iran Defeated U.S.
in ‘Trump’s Third War’ Midway

TEHRAN – The advisor to the Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Mohsen Rezaei has said the United States was defeated midway in what he called U.S. President Donald “Trump’s third war” against Iran, as Iranian forces disrupted American plans, forced the relocation of U.S. command centers, and inflicted heavy casualties, adding another major failure to Washington’s record of setbacks.

Speaking in a special television interview on Monday, Rezaei, former commander of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) during the Sacred Defense, characterized the recent American aggression as Trump’s third war against Iran, coming after earlier 12-day and 40-day conflicts.

He also revealed that Iran prepared to strike three locations inside Ukraine in response to an attack on an Iranian ship, but suspended the operation after Kiev claimed the incident was a mistake, while stressing that compensation remains obligatory.

“We were ready to attack three areas in Ukraine,” Rezaei stated, referring to the Ukrainian strike on an Iranian vessel. “But after they claimed it was a mistake, we halted our response to examine their claim. Even if it was a mistake, it still requires compensation.”

Offering condolences on the occasion of Arbaeen, Rezaei said Iran has already advanced far along the path toward victory and must, following the doctrine of the martyred Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Imam Seyyed Ali Khamenei, based on dignity, wisdom and expediency, preserve unity and steadfastness through prudence.

Rezaei recalled that Washington’s bad faith had been clear from the beginning. The U.S. violated previous understandings by creating a corridor south of the Strait of Hormuz and then bombing the area, rather than referring any dispute to the designated conflict-resolution committee involving Qatar and Saudi Arabia.

Detailing the battle of Hormuz,

Rezaei noted that Israel was absent from the latest round of attacks, which focused on southern Iran. The likely objectives were to pave the way for a ground operation to force open the Strait of Hormuz or to target Iran’s nuclear facilities.

American forces bombed communication bridges, radars and some military centers in an attempt to weaken Iranian logistics, he said. “Trump demanded heavier strikes from the CENTCOM commander because conditions for a ground operation had not been created,” Rezaei said. “But his commanders replied that maximum capability had already been used, and still they failed. This exposes the miscalculations of American military commanders.”

In response, Iran launched successive, intense and precise strikes against U.S. bases across the region. These attacks forced the relocation of American forces and shifted their command first from Qatar to Jordan and then to the Israeli

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FM Araghchi Discusses Regional Developments
With Pakistani, Omani Counterparts

TEHRAN - Iran’s Foreign Minister Seyed Abbas Araghchi has held separate telephone conversations with his counterparts from Pakistan and Oman, reviewing the latest regional developments and ongoing diplomatic efforts to strengthen peace and stability in the region.

Pakistani Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Muhammad Ishaq Dar on Monday night spoke by phone with Araghchi.

The two foreign ministers examined current regional events and the trajectory of diplomatic efforts, underscoring the need for continued close cooperation and consultations between Tehran and Islamabad to achieve lasting peace and security across the region.

The Pakistani Foreign Ministry later issued a statement on the call, confirming that Foreign Minister Dar invited his Iranian counterpart to visit Pakistan at the earliest possible opportunity.

In a separate conversation the same afternoon, Araghchi also spoke with Oman’s Foreign Minister Sayyid Badr Albusaidi. The Iranian and Omani top diplomats exchanged views on the latest regional developments.

On Sunday night, Araghchi held a series of high-level telephone conversations with his Saudi counterpart and Pakistan’s army chief as part of ongoing regional consultations aimed at preserving security and stability in West Asia.

Araghchi engaged in discussions, marking his second round of calls within 24 hours, with Saudi Foreign Minister Prince Faisal bin Farhan and Pakistan’s Chief of Army Staff Field Marshal Asim Munir.

The talks reviewed the latest diplomatic efforts and initiatives to maintain and strengthen regional security and stability. The parties emphasized the necessity of leveraging regional cooperation capacities and political solutions.

According to a statement posted on X by the Saudi Foreign Ministry, the Saudi and Iranian ministers discussed the current situation, with Al Saud emphasizing Riyadh’s

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Two High-Profile Israeli Agents Executed Over Espionage Charges

TEHRAN – Omid Behzad and Pourya Safvat have been executed by hanging after being convicted of transmitting coordinates of sensitive military and security locations to Mossad intelligence officers.

According to reports, Behzad and Safvat provided significant assistance to the Israeli intelligence service during the “Ramadan War” and the “12-Day War” by relaying coordinates, images, and intelligence regarding key military and security facilities to Mossad officers and affiliated

communication channels.

The death sentences were carried out early Monday morning following the completion of legal procedures, confirmation by the Supreme Court, and final judicial authorization.

Judicial authorities stated that the two individuals acted as operational assets on the ground under the guise of seemingly simple yet complex projects, playing a direct role in transferring critical information to enemy forces.

Technical analysis conducted

on Omid Behzad’s mobile device revealed that during the Ramadan War, he repeatedly sent coordinates, geographical positions, and data concerning military, law enforcement, and security centers to Mossad-linked channels.

During questioning, Behzad reportedly confessed, stating: “I used navigation apps like Google Maps to locate and send the coordinates of these facilities.”

According to intelligence reports, one of the primary platforms designated by enemy

President
Pezeshkian Rejects
Resignation Rumors,
Vows to Remain in Office

TEHRAN – Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian dismissed rumors that he plans to resign, saying he will remain in office and continue his work while rejecting claims of differences between his administration and the Leader of the Islamic Revolution.

In comments a televised interview marking the second anniversary of his administration, excerpts of which were released on Tuesday ahead of its broadcast on the Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcasting (IRIB), Pezeshkian stressed that his administration is fully coordinated with the country’s Armed Forces.

“We are completely coordinated with the military forces,” the president said.

Addressing speculation about his resignation, Pezeshkian firmly denied the rumors.

“If I ever decide to resign, I will announce it myself. But I will not resign, and I will stand firm,” he said.

The president added that some people are trying to create the impression that there are differences between his administration and Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyed Mojtaba Khamenei.

The remarks came after rumors about Pezeshkian’s resignation circulated in recent days.

Earlier, Muhammad Mahdi Tabatabaei, deputy for information and communications at the Office of the President, dismissed the reports as “baseless” and “an outright lie.” He lashed out at political extremists for spreading the rumors in an attempt to undermine national unity and serve the interests of Iran’s enemies.
